The Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) provide the standards we use in AISD to ensure **academic rigor in a thinking curriculum**. We recommend that you use the questions below each day to discover what your children are learning. By asking these questions regularly, you are letting your children know that you value learning and are interested in their progress.

These questions help focus children on learning goals. When children know what is expected of them, we call it **clear expectations**. When children are able to talk with others about quality work, we call it **accountable talk**. These ideas are part of the *Principles of Learning* that AISD is using to increase learning for all children.

Try using these questions at home each day and see!

Important Questions To Ask Your Child About Learning

1. Tell me one new thing you learned today.
2. Why is it important to learn that?
3. How do you know your work is good?
4. What can you do to make your work better?
