Minutes Waiver

- Texas public schools are required to provide at least 75,600 minutes of operation each school year including applicable waivers. This waiver is for staff development in place of student instruction. Only two days will be available for waiver-eligible professional development in SY22-23: October 14, 2022 and January 9, 2023.
 - Discussion was held and members wanted to ensure that campus are provided quality professional development for teachers.
