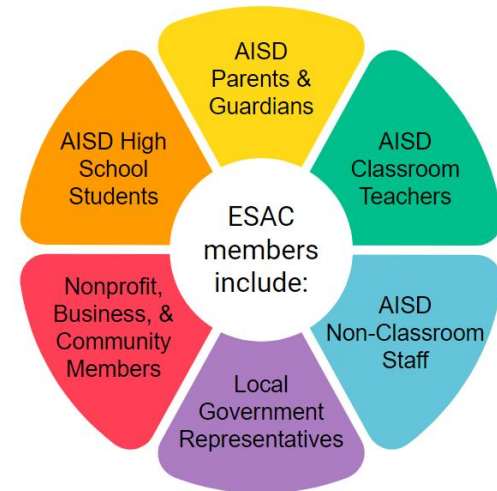

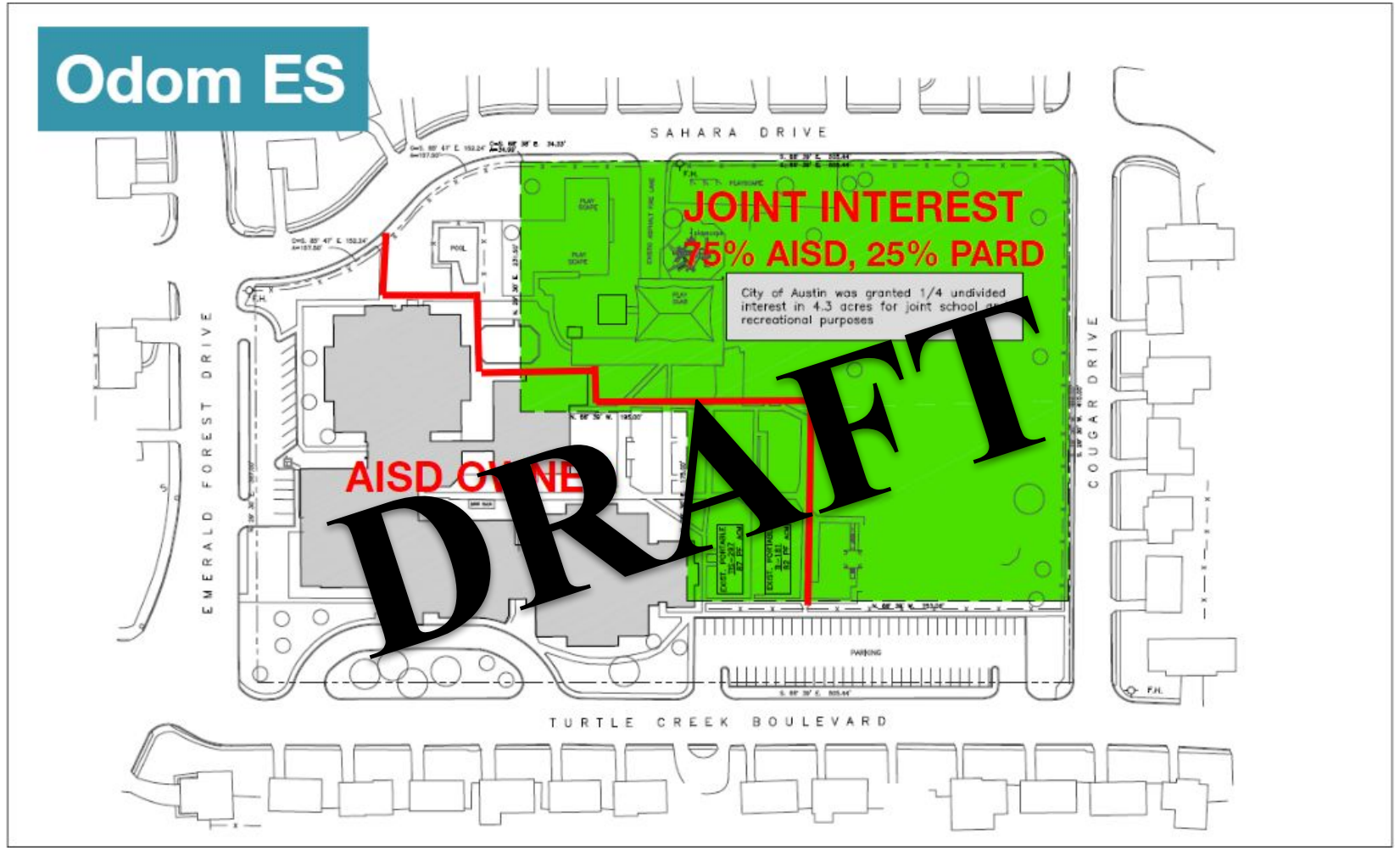


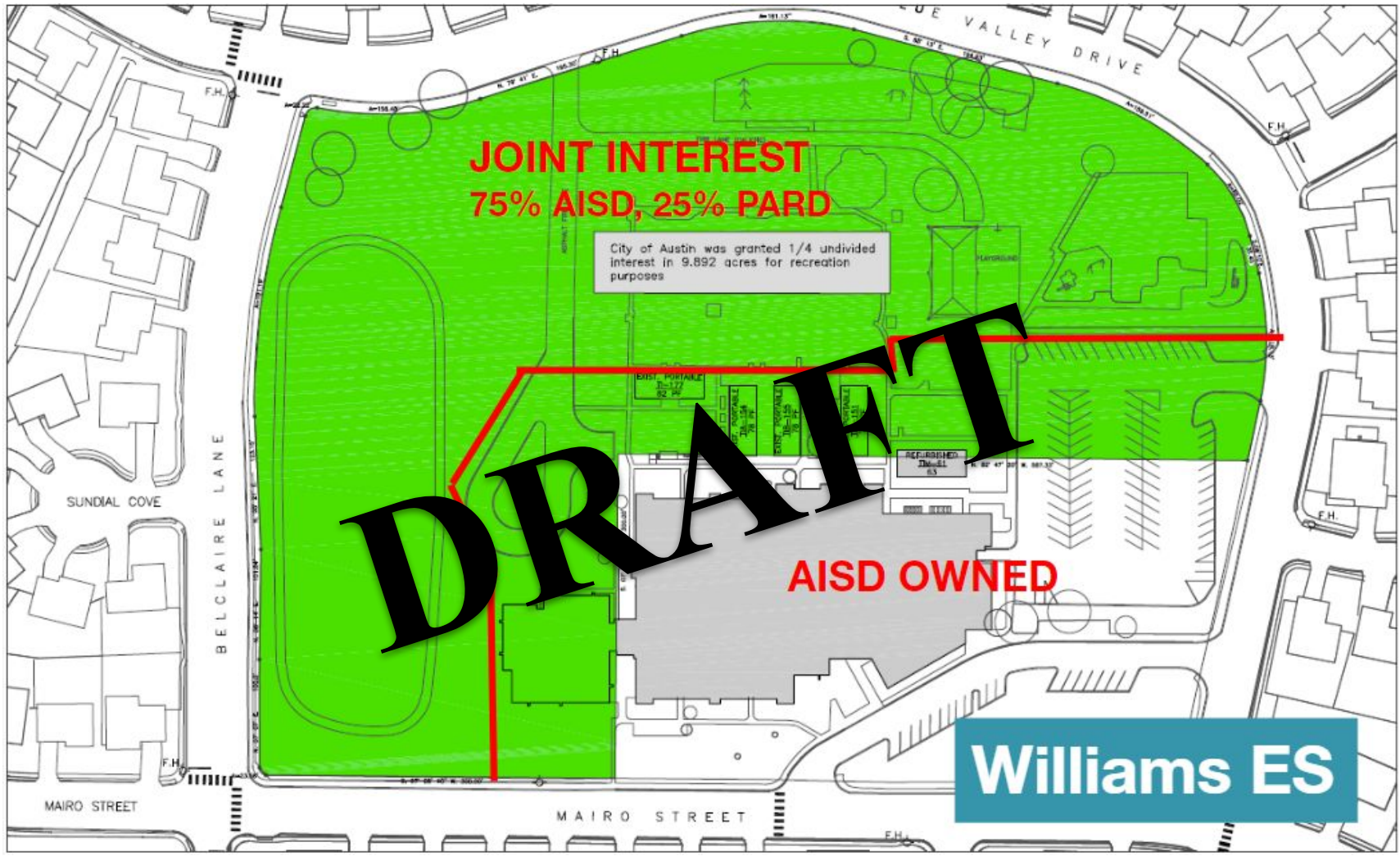
AISD/PARD Joint Use Letter

 - Pecan Springs ES
 - Williams ES
 - Wooldridge ES
- **All (9) campuses will remain joint-interest sites.** The size and location of the joint-interest area on these campuses will be revised to support Bond projects.
- Letter outlining the condemnation process and commitment to joint-interest has been drafted and will be reviewed/signed by AISD and City of Austin leadership.
