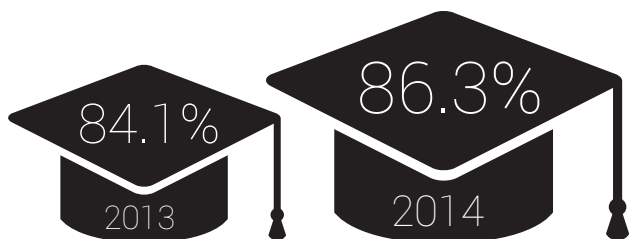


## FY2016 BUDGET
