Desired Annual Outcome 1: Goal 1 - Students identified as economically disadvantaged demonstrating achievement on 3rd grade state assessment in reading at the Meets Grade Level will increase from 34% to 60% by August 2026.

Desired Annual Outcome 2: Goal 2 - Students identified as economically disadvantaged demonstrating achievement on 3rd grade state assessment in math at the Meets Grade Level will increase from 39% to 60% by August 2026.

Desired Annual Outcome 3: Goal 3 - By May 2024, fifth-grade students' performance on the 5th-grade state science assessment, in the "Meets Grade Level" category, will improve from the current 2.17% to 50%.

Evaluation Data Sources: In the 2022-2023 school year, the distribution of student scores on the 5th Grade STAAR Science assessment was as follows:

- 69.57% of students fell into the "Did Not Meet" category.
- 28.26% of students were in the "Approaches" category.
- 2.17% of students achieved the "Meets" level.
- There were no students who scored at the "Masters" level.

Desired Annual Outcome 4: Goal 4 - Emergent bilingual students demonstrating one year growth on TELPAS will increase from 30% to 60% by August 2026.
