Priority Focus Area 2: Teacher & Employee Well-Being

Desired Annual Outcome 1: We will offer at least 4 self-care opportunities (1 per 9 weeks) for staff to participate in after or during school. The effectiveness will be measured by the the number of teacher turnover at the end of the school year.

Evaluation Data Sources: I will use the 22-23 and 23-24 teacher retention percentage. I will also use the panorama survey.
