Goal 1: Student Well-Being & Achievement

Performance Objective 1: Students in 3rd grade will increase their performance on state assessments in ELA at the Masters Level to increase from 44% to 50% or higher by August 2025.

Performance Objective 2: Goal 3 - Students in 4th grade will increase their performance on state assessments in MATH at the Meets Level to increase from 52% to 60% or higher by August 2025.

HB3 Goal

Performance Objective 3: Students in 3rd grade will be surveyed to identify known deescalation strategies. After receiving instruction on multiple new deescalation strategies, they EOY survey will show an average gain of 2 or more strategies per student. (sample BOY grade level average - students identified 3 de-escalation strategies. EOY goal - students identify an average of 5 or more strategies.)
