Goal 1: Student Attendance & Achievement

Performance Objective 1: 75% of students identified as performing in the 1st to 40th percentile in Achievement on READING MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) will perform in the 41st percentile or higher on End-of-year MAP (May 2024). (Based off of AISD School Board Goal 2)

HB3 Goal

Performance Objective 2: By May 1, 2025, student attendance rate will increase from 96% (the average attendance rate for 23-34 school year) to 96.5%.
