

## Overview of Texas School Accreditation

This resource lists the official accreditation status for every public school district and charter school in the state. Accreditation is a mandatory requirement for a school to operate and is determined by two primary factors:

- Academic Accountability Ratings: Performance based on state testing and progress.
- Financial Ratings (FIRST): Evaluations from the Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas.

The interactive table allows the public to search by district name or County District Number (CDN) to view specific ratings, including Superior Achievement, Substandard Achievement, or instances where a charter has been revoked.
