



# **Educational Suitability Summary Report**

Blazier Elementary School

Date: 07/29/2016 Score 78% Good

Blazier Elementary School is serving a student population of approximately 860 students in Southeast Austin. From the interview with faculty and the campus assessments, the campus demonstrates overall conditions of 'Good' for educational suitability. A variety of deficiencies were noted but tend to be created from the capacity and current enrollment. The campus meets current Ed Spec requirements, but programs are limited, due to the 16 portables on site. The Gym and Cafeteria layout is typical of AISD layouts, and the library supports different sized groups. Site traffic flow works well currently, but as the adjacent neighborhoods are developed, onsite stacking at the parent loop may be affected.

## **Survey Overview**

Survey results from teachers and administrators were not completed. The educational suitability for most major spaces, including library, gym, classrooms, common spaces, administrative offices, and outdoor spaces was determined by a principal interview and field assessment.

#### **Interview Overview**

Ms. Leti Pena was present during the onsite interview. Discussions focused on the current high enrollment and how this issue could be resolved. Through the upcoming bond plan, the demographics may need to revisit this portion of the district. Due to the high enrollment, portables are heavily used on the site. As a result of being over capacity, the types of programs provided are limited.

Currently, drop off and pick up work very well. Large amounts of buses reduce the parent traffic. Site lighting is appropriate. Playgrounds do not meet the district standards. The track has been reduced in size due to the portables, and the playground has to be scheduled, due to size.

Technology needs are apparent. Currently the campus has a 4:1 ratio, but would prefer to be at a 2:1 device to student ratio. The campus recently purchased projectors for each classroom but need a presentation solution due to the innovation stations not meeting the current need.

The campus staff would like more flexible learning spaces, outdoor areas, and more 'Pods' like the 5<sup>th</sup> grade and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade hallways have.

Security overall is adequate, but the portables cause issues with travel and lighting.

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#### **Assessment Findings**

The Educational Suitability Assessment of Blazier Elementary School earned a 78% overall score and places the campus in a category of 'Good'. The assessment consists of 11 categories to determine areas that need more attention.

## **Lower Scoring Categories:**

#### **Exterior**

Score is Average.

Traffic circulation for vehicular, bus, and pedestrian traffic is clearly noted, and separated. The building signage and wayfinding is adequate. Lighting for nighttime use, is satisfactory. Outdoor learning spaces are unsatisfactory due to lack locations to place them. Fencing was recently placed around the campus due to the amount of portables placed on the site. Additionally, the play spaces are inadequate in size, and could be more appropriately located on the site. The track has shrunk due to the amount of portables placed on the site.

## **Security**

Score is Average.

The location of the central office is satisfactory in configuration for creating a secure entry to the school. Key card access is at all major entries. Interior transparency is good for faculty supervision within the school. Overall the main campus security is adequate. The addition of multiple portables provides issues through poor lighting, and travel between the main building and portables.

#### **Higher Scoring Categories:**

#### **General Building**

Score is Excellent.

The access for community functions and the general appearance of the school including the main entry are nice attributes. The arrangement of school spaces allow nighttime use of the school and the corridors are appropriately sized in width. Due to the current high enrollment, there are many portables at the campus. The portables cause issues with travel between the main building and outlaying classrooms.

## **Future Ready Student Development**

Score is Good.

The classroom spaces are adequately sized and have appropriate storage space to accommodate project-based learning. The school lacks adequate display space for student work, but has adequate visual communication tools within classrooms.

## Library/Media Center

Score is Excellent.

The library has space and flexibility for collaborative work of different group sizes. There is a need for other casual seating to support social interaction and separation for areas for individual

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study. In addition, the library has satisfactory technological support. The furniture could be mobile, but the campus staff uses the space well.

#### Storage

Score is Excellent.

General building storage is adequate and allocated to the corridors. Additionally, classroom storage spaces are equipped with lots of built-in cabinets.

## **Controllability of Systems**

Score is Good.

The classrooms have individual thermal controls and effective shades for controlling natural light. However, the artificial lighting controls are limited to only on/off switch for alternating half the light in the classroom.

## **Academic & Co-Curricular Support**

Score is Excellent.

The furniture does allow for different layouts, since the chairs are not attached to the desk top. Kinder spaces currently are in the main building, and are satisfactory for storage and configuration. Pre-K was recently removed from the campus. P.E. support spaces are sufficient in size. The corridor to access outdoor space is not appropriately placed for direct playground access. The dining facility needs and additional serving line with the schools current enrollment.

#### **Technology**

Score is Good.

Common facilities lack instructional technology, but classrooms have computers and campus provided projectors. The integration stations are at an end life period and need to be replaced, or a better option needs to be provided.

## Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment

Score is Excellent.

Furniture is satisfactory in condition and size, yet does not allow for easy reconfiguration of the space for different learning groups. The furniture allows for reconfiguration with some effort. Library furniture is heavy wooden furniture, but the campus staff has laid out the furniture well.

#### **Environmental Quality**

Score is Good.

The quality of the artificial lighting is appropriate for classroom functions. The acoustics are inadequate as sounds are easily heard from the corridor and adjacent classroom spaces. More than half of learning spaces have exterior views. The shared classroom restroom layout needs a door between the classrooms to help alleviate noise transference.


