



## **Educational Suitability Summary Report**

Joslin Elementary School

Date: 07/11/2016 Score 53% Average

Joslin Elementary School is serving a student population of approximately 280 students in South Austin. After interviewing the Principal, as well as conducting a campus walk assessment, the facility exhibits an overall average condition for educational suitability. Deficiencies found were primarily focused on the age of the main classroom building and the lack of classroom space. This also leads to a campus described as neither inspiring nor inviting.

### **Survey Overview**

The only survey provided was from the principal and summarized nearly all spaces as unsatisfactory. The physical condition of the restrooms were noted as very unsatisfactory. Only the condition of the grounds, play structures, walking/running areas were considered satisfactory. The survey yielded a need for a theater/performance space, more storage, hands-on project spaces, small group learning, quiet study and spaces to allow for instructional technology in classrooms.

### **Interview Overview**

From the interview with the principal, the main spaces thought to not be suitable were the general classrooms being very dated and small due to the age of the building. The library lacked reading stairs/tiered seating area for group interaction. Special education rooms are in standard classrooms. Of the three, only one classroom has sufficient storage and a connected restroom. The assistant principal's offices is disconnected from the rest of administrative offices and makes it difficult to communicate effectively and efficiently.

The campus lacks appropriate meeting and conference rooms. The art and music room are in extremely old portables with inappropriate support spaces. The entry to the main building is extremely unclear to visitors. Furniture throughout the campus is new but not flexible. Parking is insufficient for staff and resort to parking across street at an adjacent building at a community church that assists many homeless.

The principal has expressed some safety concerns on the campus with current camera surveillance system is not user friendly or efficient. There have been thefts in the pasts but cameras have not captured the image because of several blind spots throughout campus. Exterior lighting is extremely poor and old. Parking is insufficient for staff and resort to parking across street at an adjacent building at a community church that assists many homeless. With the amount of homeless near the school it is cause for concern for the safety of students. There has been only one incident in the past but the community is split on how to approach the issue.

Should any major renovations occur on campus, measures should be taken to preserve or salvage the murals throughout the building as well as the courtyard space.

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The most critical issues for the campus is the age of the building and not being conducive to technology and many of AISD's initiatives. There are an inadequate number of electrical outlets in the classrooms. Among some of the desired improvements to the campus would be to have more collaborative and flexible spaces, multipurpose assembly rooms and include a maker space. Performance area instead of the cafetorium configuration would be ideal. For the overall campus updating the lighting as well as improvements to the ceilings.

### **Assessment Findings**

The Educational Suitability Assessment of Joslin Elementary School earned a 53% overall score and places the campus in a category of average. The assessment consists of 11 categories to determine areas that need more attention.

### **Lower Scoring Categories:**

### Storage

Score is very unsatisfactory.

General building storage has minimal storage rooms. Classrooms have inadequate amount of furniture and casework and dated.

### **Academic & Co-Curricular Support**

Score is unsatisfactory.

Classrooms are too small due to age of building. Support spaces are insufficient such as classroom and student storage. General appearance of campus is aged but ok. Although floor mats in gym are new, the overall space is small and the basketball goals are inadequate. Music and Art rooms are in portables and the performance spaced limited to a dated cafetorium stage and support spaces are too small. Special education rooms are converted classrooms. Only one of the life skills has the appropriate support spaces with washer and dryers and a shower.

### **Future Ready Student Development**

Score is unsatisfactory.

Campus has limited dedicated spaces of moderate size and layout with equipment and furniture for hands-on project based learning. Storage is moderately sized casework and on average there are only 1 walls in classrooms or some hallway space to display student work. Classrooms have two walls with windows and one wall with cabinets. Few common spaces throughout the school. Most classrooms have a mix of old and new visual communication tools with projectors and marker boards in good condition.

### **Technology**

Score is unsatisfactory.

Within the classrooms there are a few computers and/or devices with a mix of new and outdated technology. The connection in the classrooms are very limited to just one for the teacher. There is a need for added network and electrical connectivity to support technology.

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#### **Exterior**

Score is average.

Site does not permit ideal traffic circulation. Buses, cars and pedestrians are somewhat separate but there is no canopy or holding place. Signage is visible but not apparent. Parking is an issue for staff and have to park across the street.

### Library/Media Center

Score is average.

The library has some space and flexibility for collaborative work of different group sizes. Library is spacious with plenty of seating but no specialized area for social interaction. In addition, the library has some technological support with some power outlets some network connectivity. Has separate access with its own entry from a parking lot for visitors but far from main entry of building and in a newer building.

### Security

Score is average.

The location of the central office is located close to the entry to the school but no secure vestibule. Additional lighting needed as well as camera upgrades.

### Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment

Score is average.

Furniture is in average condition, scratched and marked and not flexible. Library chairs are age appropriate for adults or taller students.

### **Controllability of Systems**

Score is average.

The classrooms have individual thermal controls and blinds for controlling natural light. However, the artificial lighting controls are limited to only one on/off switch and the blinds are in poor condition.

### **Higher Scoring Categories:**

### **Environmental Quality**

Score is good.

The quality of acoustics are inadequate as sounds are easily heard from the corridor and adjacent classroom spaces. All classrooms and learning spaces have natural lighting, exterior views, and sufficient artificial lighting. The campus has rodent and odor issues.

### General Building

Score is good.

Circulation routes are wide enough to safely and effectively accommodate student movement with primary corridors 8-10 feet wide. All main community use areas are arranged without full school access. The overall building is aged but maintained.


