Pecan Springs Elementary, serving a student population of approximately 460 students, is an East Austin school that supports dual language. The overall educational suitability of the campus is average. The campus has deficiencies with having programs in suitable spaces; namely the art and music rooms. The campus has no true conference rooms to have meetings, and lacks technology in classrooms. Improvements are also needed with security and pest control.

# **Survey Overview**

The online survey was completed by teachers and a parent from Pecan Springs Elementary. From these responses, the spaces that were highly desired include storage, hands-on project space, mentor and tutoring space, and small group learning spaces. The respondents were satisfied overall with the art room, the counselor offices and half of respondents were satisfied with the gym. The respondents were unsatisfied overall with the building image.

#### **Interview Overview**

In the meeting with the principal, she stated, "Nothing should remain, although the landscaping is nice". She also feels that a definition of program in real spaces is very important. The campus has a few programs that are not in their suitable spaces; a standard classroom has been appropriated for a computer lab and visual arts spaces. There is no real assembly space for all of the student body of the campus and also no conference/meeting rooms throughout the school. The Parent Resources room is improperly located in a portable away from the main building. The school has a typical classroom size of 50 students but the classrooms are too small to fit all 50 students in one session. It also lacks a central science lab. Therefore, the students perform science experiments in the classroom and these rooms lack the size and flexibility to function appropriately. There are no restrooms close to the children's dining facility. There is an overall lack of storage throughout the campus, especially for the Pre-K classes. The playgrounds lack appropriate shelter and shading cover. The campus needs appropriate lighting, especially for the playground areas and the front of the school. Windows are inoperable for ventilation and are in poor condition where pests are able to enter the building. Due to that, there are pest issues on campus including rodents and sometimes foxes. There have been a few more security issues on the campus like unsecured vestibule, lack of camera and buzzer system in the annex Pre-k building and non-functional key card access to major entries. The school is lacking overall in technology such as innovation stations and projectors. The general appearance of the school is dated and is constantly requiring work or renovation.

# **Assessment Findings**

The Educational Suitability Assessment of Pecan Springs Elementary earned a 57% overall score and

places the campus in a category of average. The assessment consists of 11 categories to determine areas that need more attention.

# **Lower Scoring Categories:**

# **Future Ready Student Development**

The score is unsatisfactory.

The classroom spaces are inadequately sized and lack appropriate storage space to accommodate project-based learning. A specialized learning space shares areas with storage and offices. Additionally, the school lacks adequate display space for student work, as backpack hangars in the hallways for student storage limit use of the hallways. There is inadequate visual communication tools within classrooms, chalkboards are still in place and lacking innovation stations.

# **Storage**

The score is unsatisfactory.

The general building storage is very inadequate throughout the campus. Classroom storage spaces are equipped with only minimal built-in cabinets. Additionally, there are no student lockers or places in the classroom for students to place their backpacks.

# **Technology**

The score is unsatisfactory.

The common facilities lack instructional technology. The classrooms lack innovation stations. Power locations could be improved to reduce extension cord use.

## **Exterior**

The score is average.

Traffic circulation for vehicular, bus, and pedestrian traffic is not clearly noted. The building is lacking clear signage and wayfinding as well as adequate lighting for nighttime use. Outdoor learning spaces are very unsatisfactory due to lack of proximity to the main building and lack of fencing. Additionally, the play spaces are adequate in size, but could be more appropriately located in relation to the gym.

#### Academic & Co-Curricular Support

The score is average.

Overall, the facility's chairs and desks are not flexible to allow for different group sizes and teaching methods. Athletic support spaces are insufficient in size and lack lighting as the gym is not very flexible and is missing windows for natural light. The Music room is not appropriately configured with carpet and is not adequate in size. In addition; sound system, storage, and curtains were in poor condition for the performance spaces. The visual arts room is not adequate in size and is missing proper equipment such as sink basins. Moreover, there is virtually no central computer lab other than the few computers that are in a portable. Special Ed space is an appropriated standard classroom that is inadequate in size with small bathrooms

placed awkwardly.

# Security

The score is average.

The location of the central office is very unsatisfactory in configuration for creating a secure entry to the school. The principal expressed concern that there was no vestibule and that parents were able to enter the school as they pleased. In addition, the main office is located away from a central hallway and the windows on the classroom doors are small in size. Key card access is not at all major entries. The pests and rodents are an issue too.

# **Environmental Quality**

The score is average.

The quality of the artificial lighting is appropriate for classroom functions, while the acoustics are inadequate as sounds are easily heard from the corridor and adjacent classroom spaces. About half of the learning spaces have exterior views. The security metal grids are blocking much of the daylight entering the class. Additionally, the teachers' lounge has a smell. A staff member also expressed concern with the odor of the children's restrooms.

## **General Building**

The score is average.

The building is dated and in poor condition despite the pleasant courtyard spaces. Only the gym is arranged to allow night functions without full school access.

## **Controllability of Systems**

The score is average.

The classrooms have individual thermal controls and effective shades for controlling natural light. However, the artificial lighting controls are limited to alternating row switch which is very unsatisfactory for artificial lighting level control.

## **Higher Scoring Categories:**

# Library/Media Center

The score is good.

The library only has one entrance and is not close to the main entrance. Individual reading spots could be increased. The library has a lack of space and flexibility for collaborative work of different group sizes. The library has social stairs for students to play and communicate. In addition, the library has unsatisfactory technological support.

## **Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment**

The score is excellent.

Furniture in the library is dated but the student desks and chairs appear new.






Photo 5. 4.1 Specialized Learning Space




Photo 6. 4.4 Visual Space




Photo 8. 6.3 Main Entrance
