### **PROCEEDINGS**

#### **Preliminaries**

- The meeting was called to order at 4:31 p.m. in the Board Auditorium by Dr. Jane Ross.
- There were no citizen communications.
- Under reports from members serving on other district advisory committees, reports were given on the ELLAC, Innovation Design Team, and Board of Realtors work group.
- The DAC moved to reaffirm Dr. Ross as staff co-chair for another two-year term.
- After hearing from candidates seeking to serve on the DAC Executive Committee, Joey Crumley distributed election ballots. He said he would notify the DAC the next day of the results.

## **TEA Waiver Requests Related to High School Early Release Dates**

- Craig Shapiro, Associate Superintendent for High Schools, announced that the waivers would not be needed after all. He said that enough minutes had been built into the high school calendar to cover the early releases.
- Mr. Shapiro did take the opportunity to briefly go over the advantages of having the early releases.

## **Food Services Update**

- Annelies Tanner, Food Services Director, stated that the mission on Food Services is to support the academic achievement and well-being of all students through nutritious meals.
- Ms. Tanner provided a presentation with three focus areas: food access, nutrition education, and sustainability. She explained free and reduced-price breakfast and lunch, breakfast in the classroom, after-school meals, and summer food service.
- Ms. Tanner also went over food standards, special dietary needs, menu innovation, use of local products, and composting.
- Discussion points included:
  - Unused food is shared with the community as much as possible
  - Providing more information to parents would be helpful
  - Our food offerings need to be part of our overall district marketing plan
  - Putting more money into each meal is a worthwhile investment
  - The food services budget is separate not part of the general budget
  - Federal funding is provided, and the government sets the income guidelines
  - Most campuses currently participate in community composting through pick-up of materials not many campuses practice composting on-site
  - Salad bars are being rolled out district-wide
  - Breakfast in the classroom is a campus choice

- All school kitchens are well-equipped
- Campus food services staff receive culinary training
- It would definitely help to get PTA assistance
- Catering services are available
- We're trying to make school cafeterias eating destinations

## Superintendent's Update

- Dr. Cruz provided an update that included the following topics:
  - Food services is a great example of how we can get things done
  - The district is honoring police officers at this season's football games
  - We have seen continued good results in state accountability, AP exams, and ACT scores
  - The district is sponsoring an upcoming conference on dyslexia
  - Our graduation rate has reached an all-time high of 89.7%
- Discussion points included:
  - The new BOLT system still has a lot of issues, including payroll
  - Payroll staff have been working very hard, even on weekends, and this is a top priority
  - There are limitations on the district providing financial assistance to people not getting their paychecks on time
  - We will continue with project-based learning and standards-based grading, but we probably won't see state assessments easing up
  - The state accountability system includes "artificial" failures for Special Education students who exceed a state passing cap
