- -Discussion of the campus staffing needs, who can provide all the intervention on campus.. Many campuses only have one reading specialist to serve all students.
- -Discussion of the evaluations and the current ability of AISD to complete all evaluations. There is a shortage of people trained to evaluate, despite the additional 1 year fund from TEA to help support.
