
- All participants in this meeting must select a language.







The EAC works in various subcommittees to draft recommendations to the Superintendent about how to address system wide inequities. Since the EAC is volunteer based, we want the district to own the next steps to implement our recommendations. Each of the subcommittee's focus areas are pulled from the equity action plan since those were inequities identified by community members. Right now, we are really looking to increase community voice in our subcommittees--if you are interested, we can connect you with the EAC coordinators.
