2025 Austin ISD Consolidations



Next steps:

- January 2026
- June-July 2026 (Summer)
 - Move coordination
- August 2026 (SY26-27)
 - School Start
 - Re-use of materials?
- Future: More opportunities





- Reuse: If the District recommends reuse, it means the campus will be repurposed to accommodate the District's administrative needs. The campus would not reopen to serve grades K-12.
- 2. **Lease:** If the District recommends a **lease**, it means the District will maintain long-term ownership of the campus but lease it to a third-party organization. The goal will be to yield some community benefit while also reducing or eliminating the cost burden of operating and maintaining the campus.
- 3. **Sale:** If the District recommends a **sale**, it means the District will issue a call for offers and sell the campus to the highest bidder to maximize revenue.


