- Mr. Linscomb suggested that we begin with the most suggested names.
- Ms. Wolf pointed out mistake in spreadsheet: Bob Lanier is not African American.
- 5:17 Discussed renaming after Diana Castañeda.
 - Ms. Cervantes read a statement in favor. It will be added to the council's google docs.
 - Mr. ______ spoke in favor.
- 5:22 Discussed how the committee might filter the name choices.

Mr. Grayson suggested we decide on basic criteria - for example, we want to name after a person, or we want to name after a local figure.
