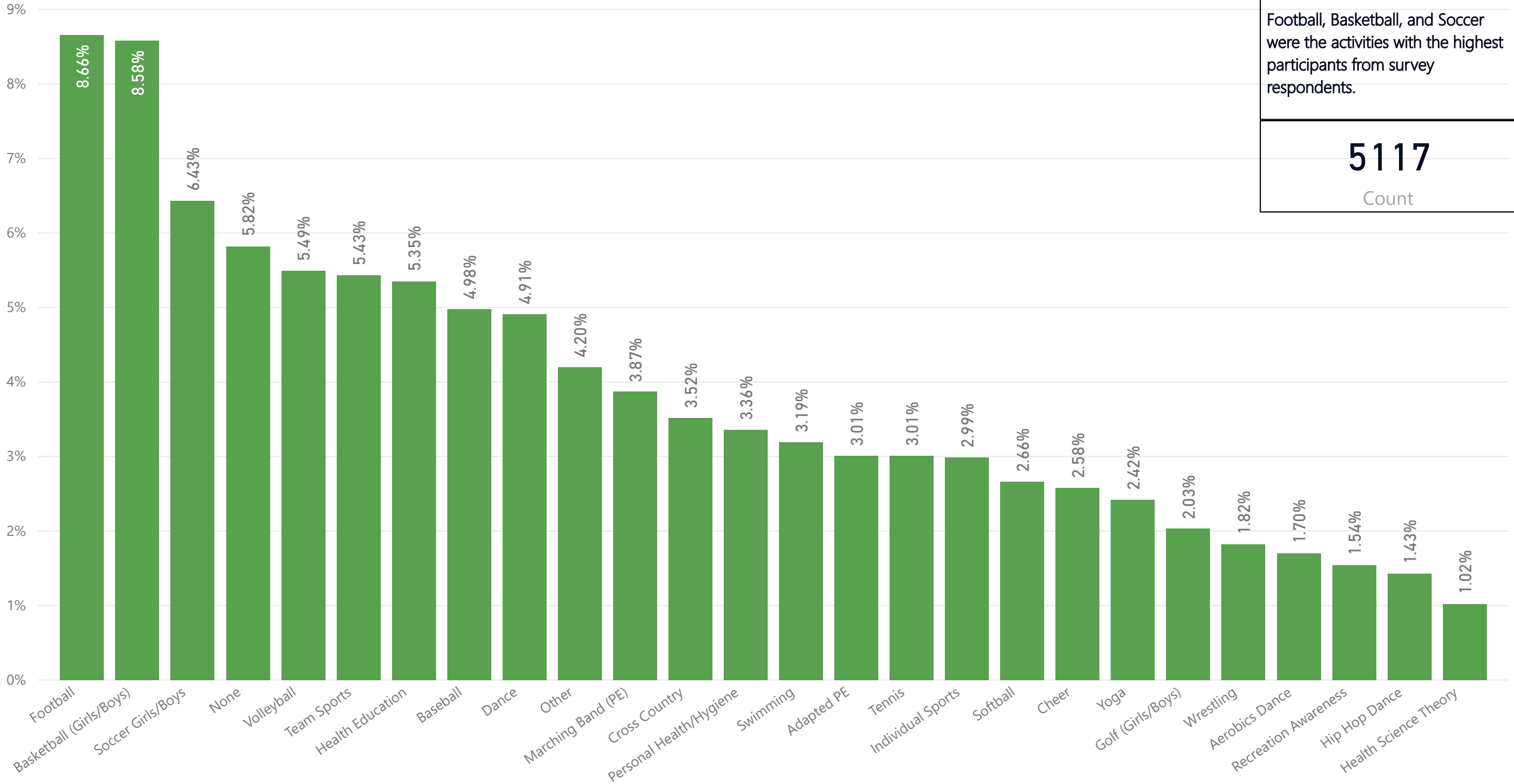
Q3.1 - What sports/wellness activities do you participate in or attend/support that are currently offered within AISD?

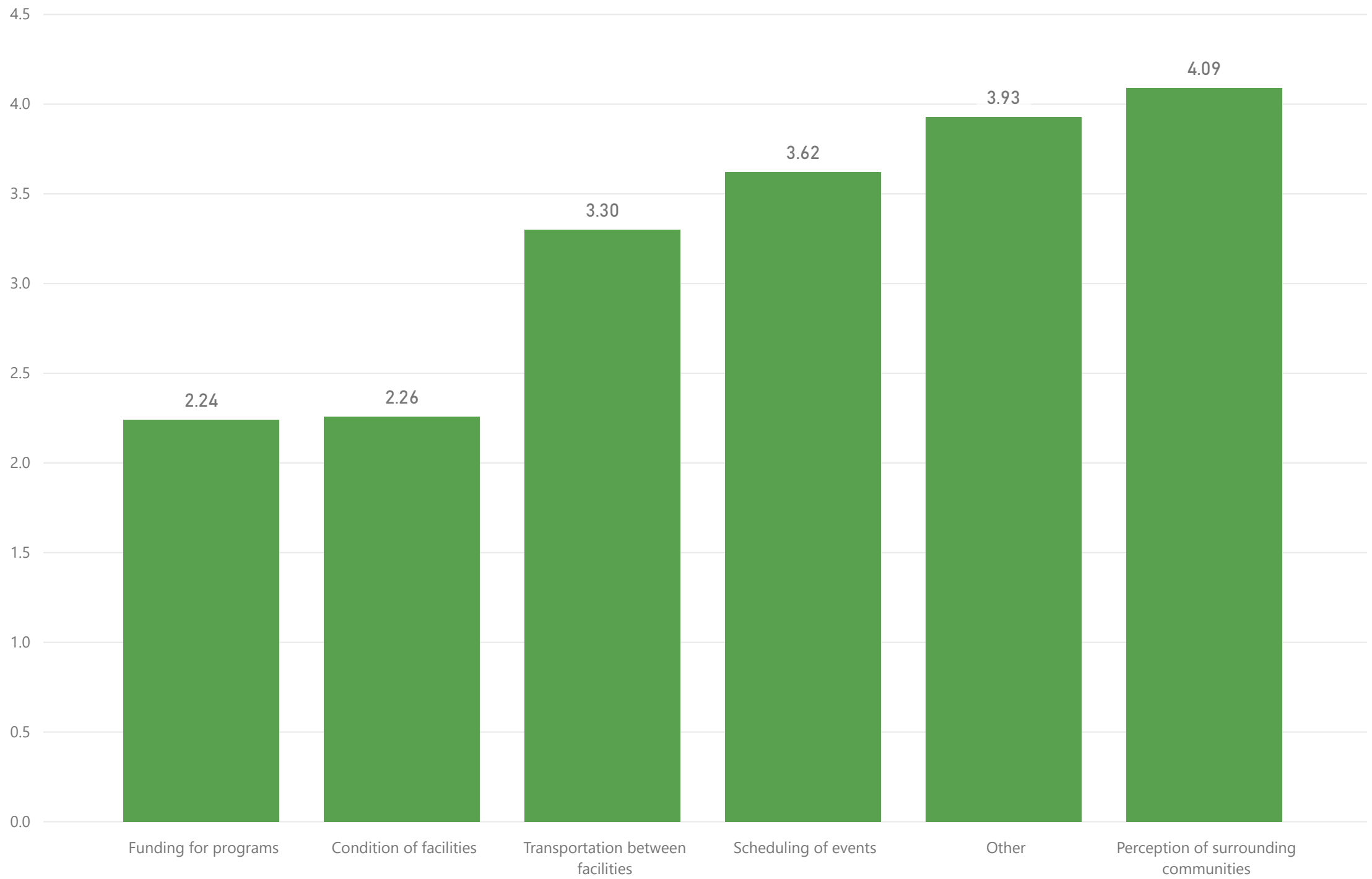
Football, Basketball, and Soccer were the activities with the highest participants from survey respondents.

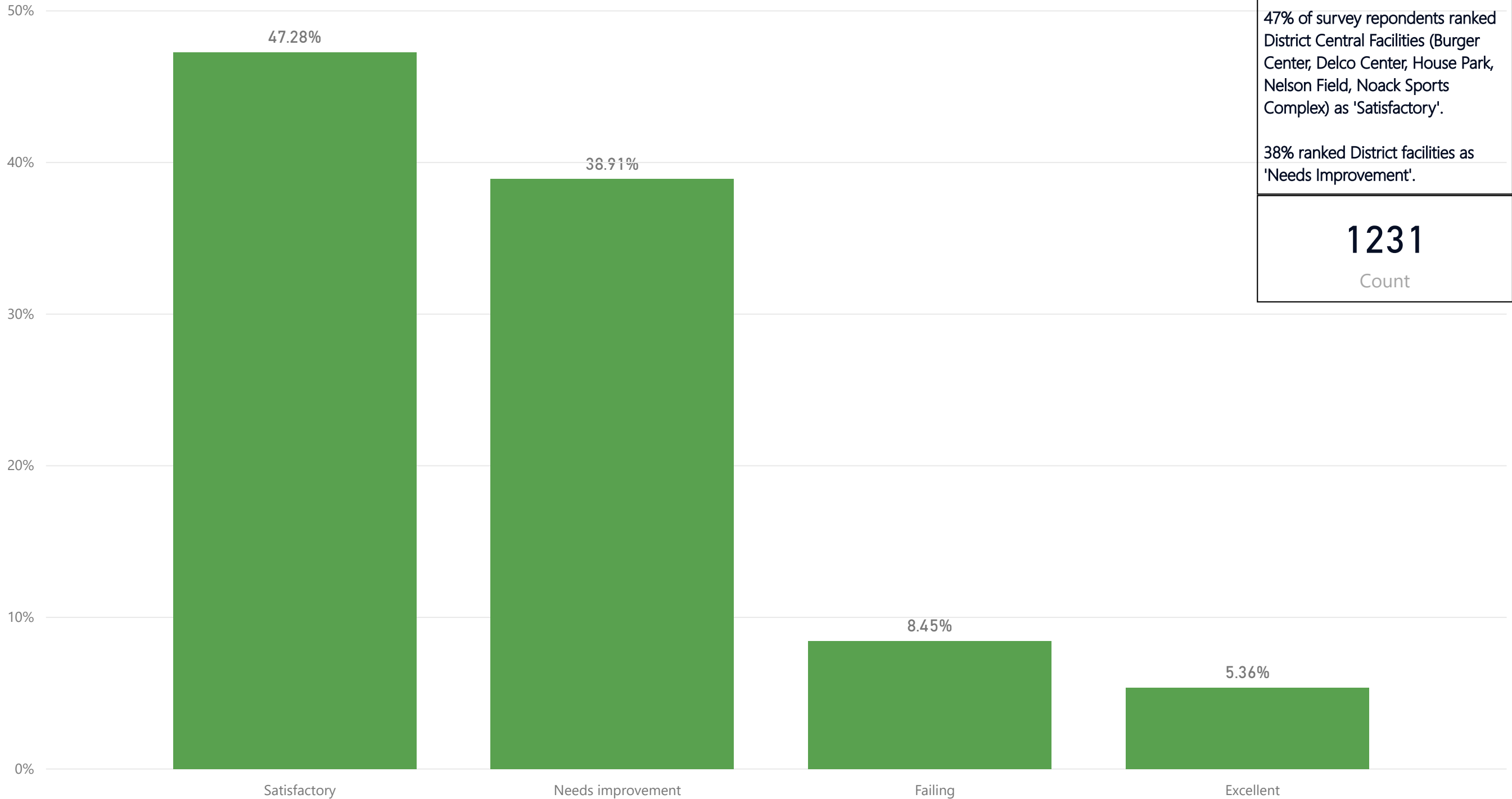

Q3.4 - What is your opinion about the condition of the current AISD athletic facilities at the school(s) where you play, support, or attend most events?

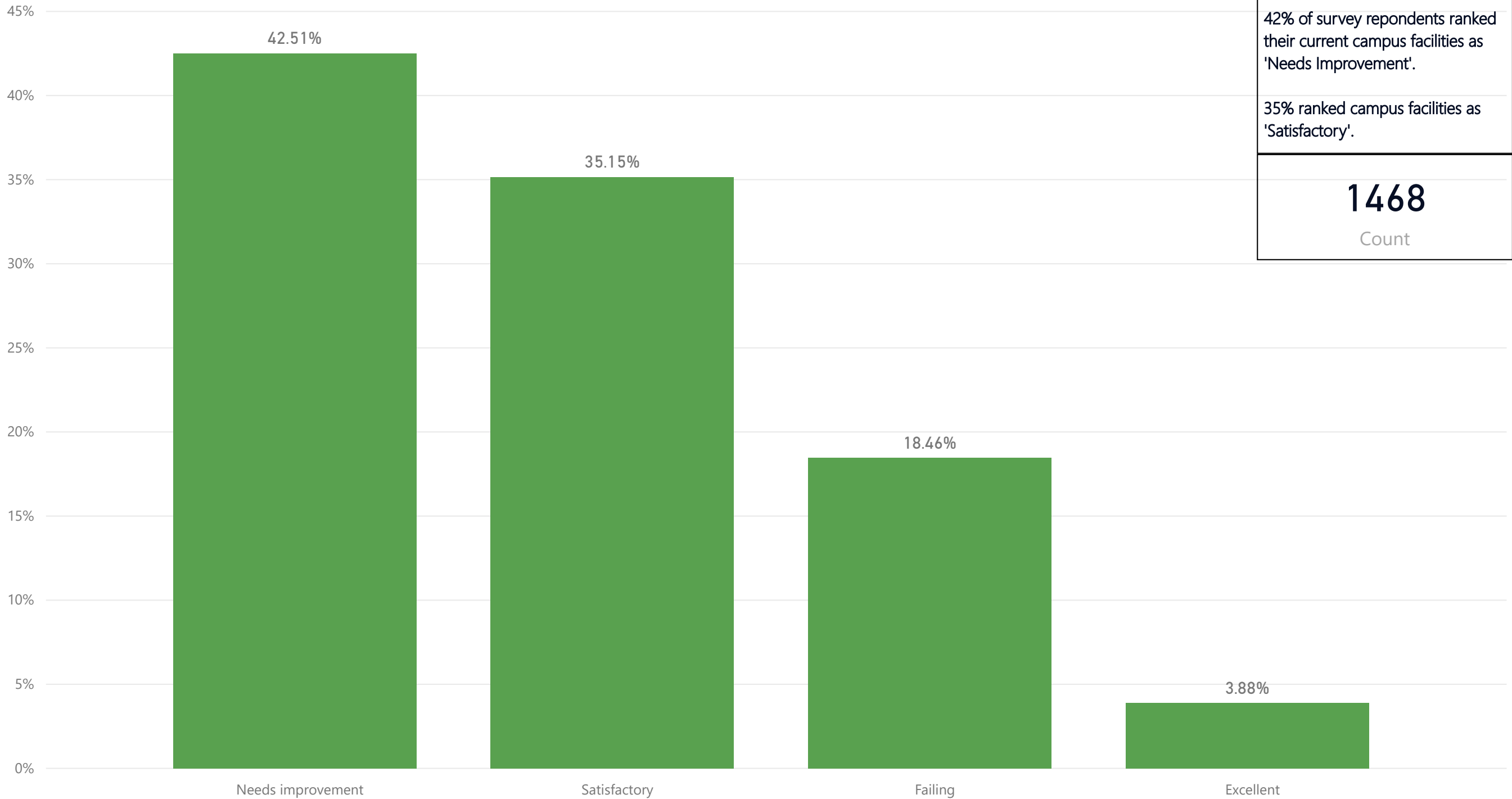
Summary:

Q3.5 - Do you feel that the current athletic facilities are well utilized (with full schedules)?

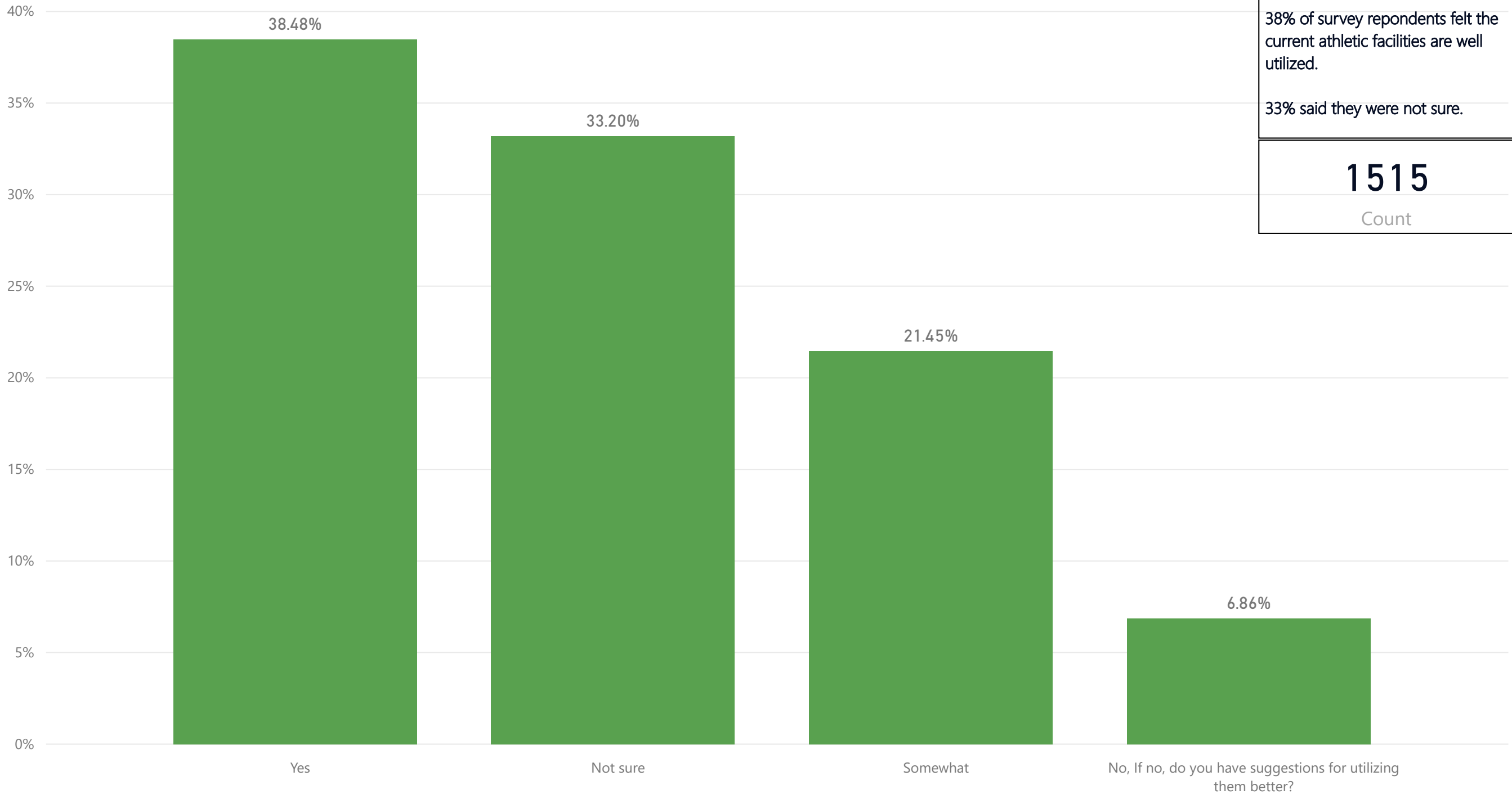

Q3.6 - Which strategy would increase student participation the most?

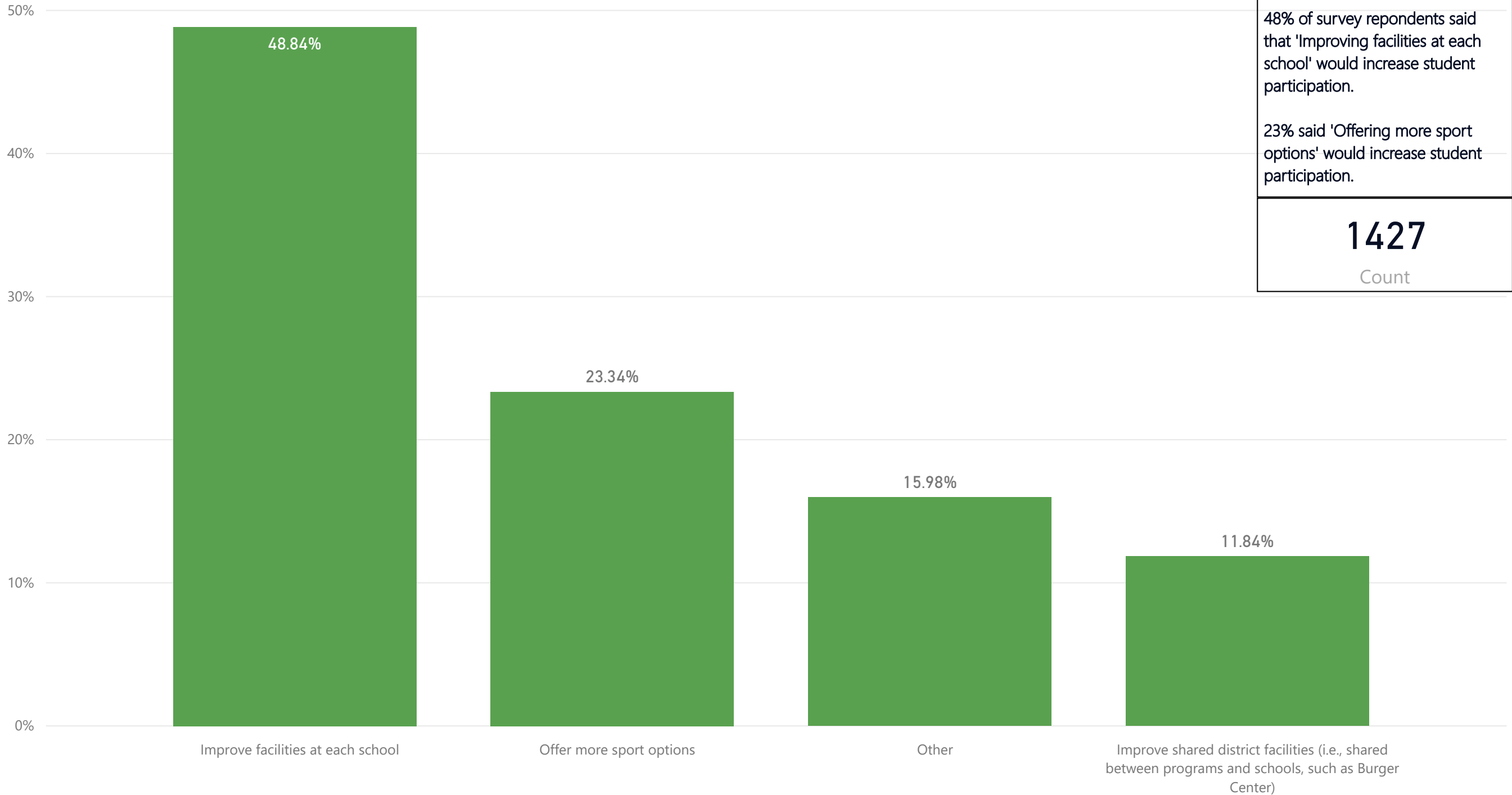

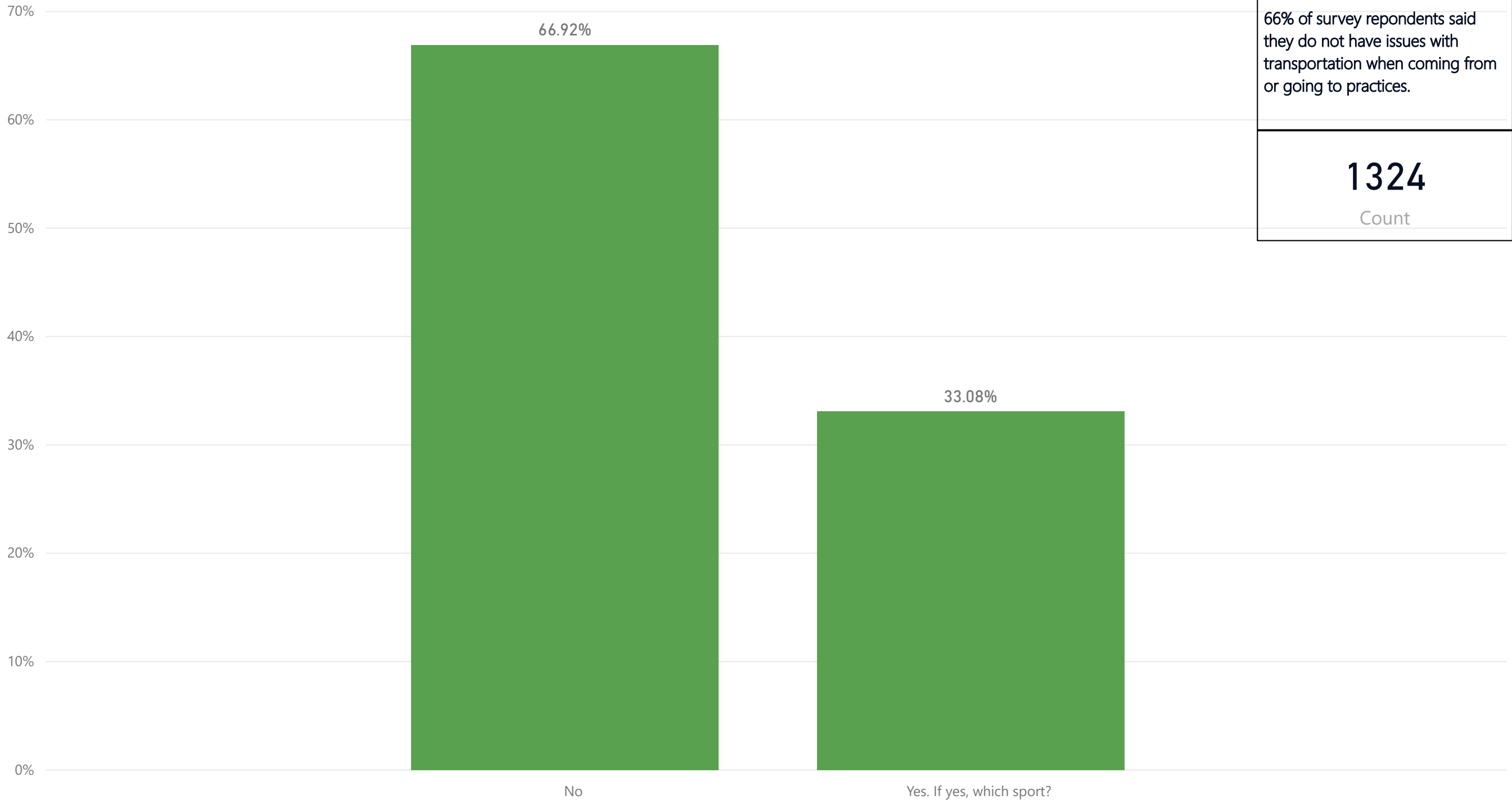
Q3.7 - Is transportation an issue, such as getting to early morning practices (like swimming) or getting home from after-school practices?

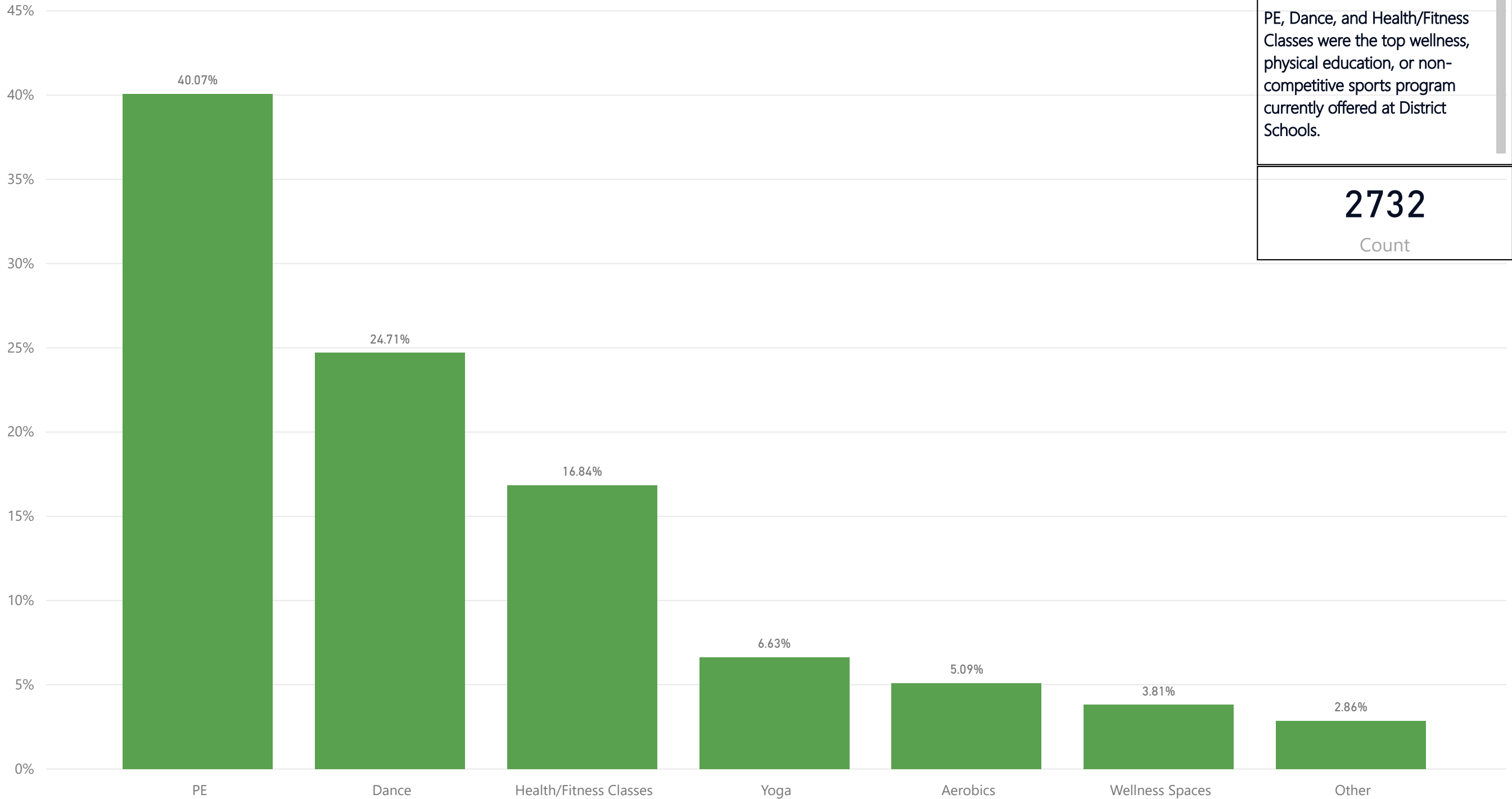
Q3.8 - What wellness, physical education, or non-competitive sports programs does your school currently offer? Check all that apply.

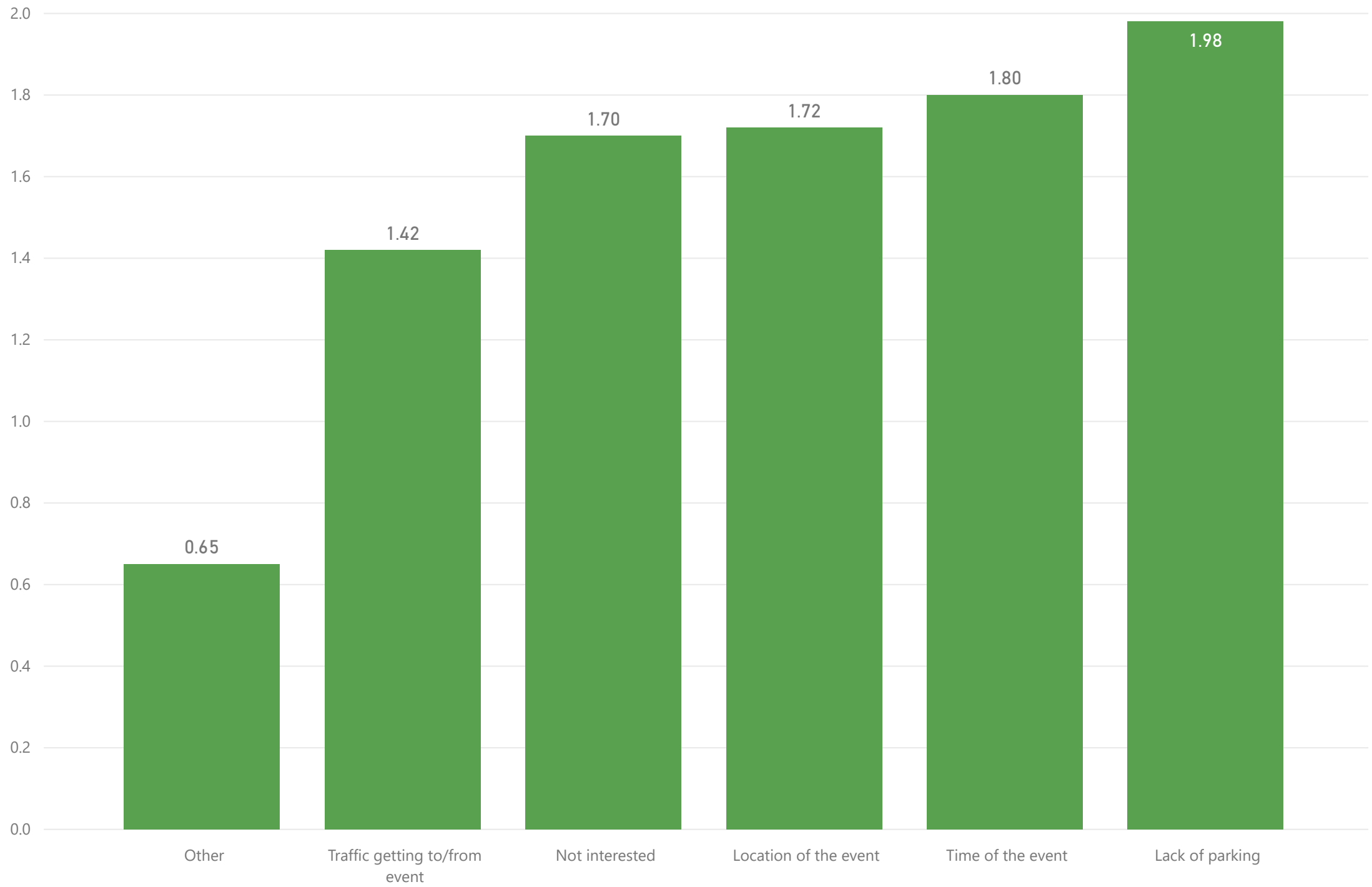
PE, Dance, and Health/Fitness Classes were the top wellness, physical education, or non-competitive sports program currently offered at District Schools.

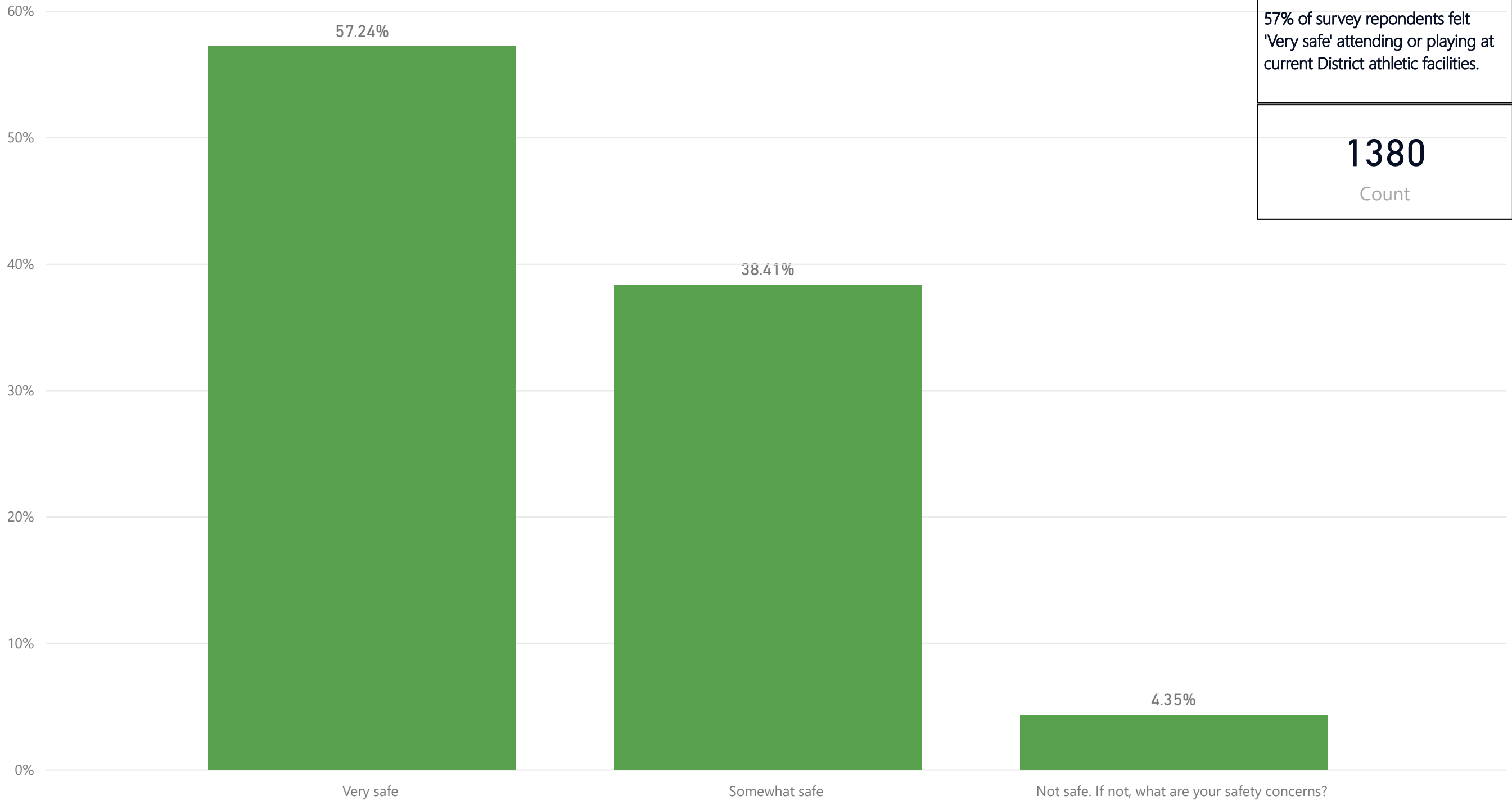
Q3.11 - How safe do you feel attending or playing at current AISD athletics facilities?

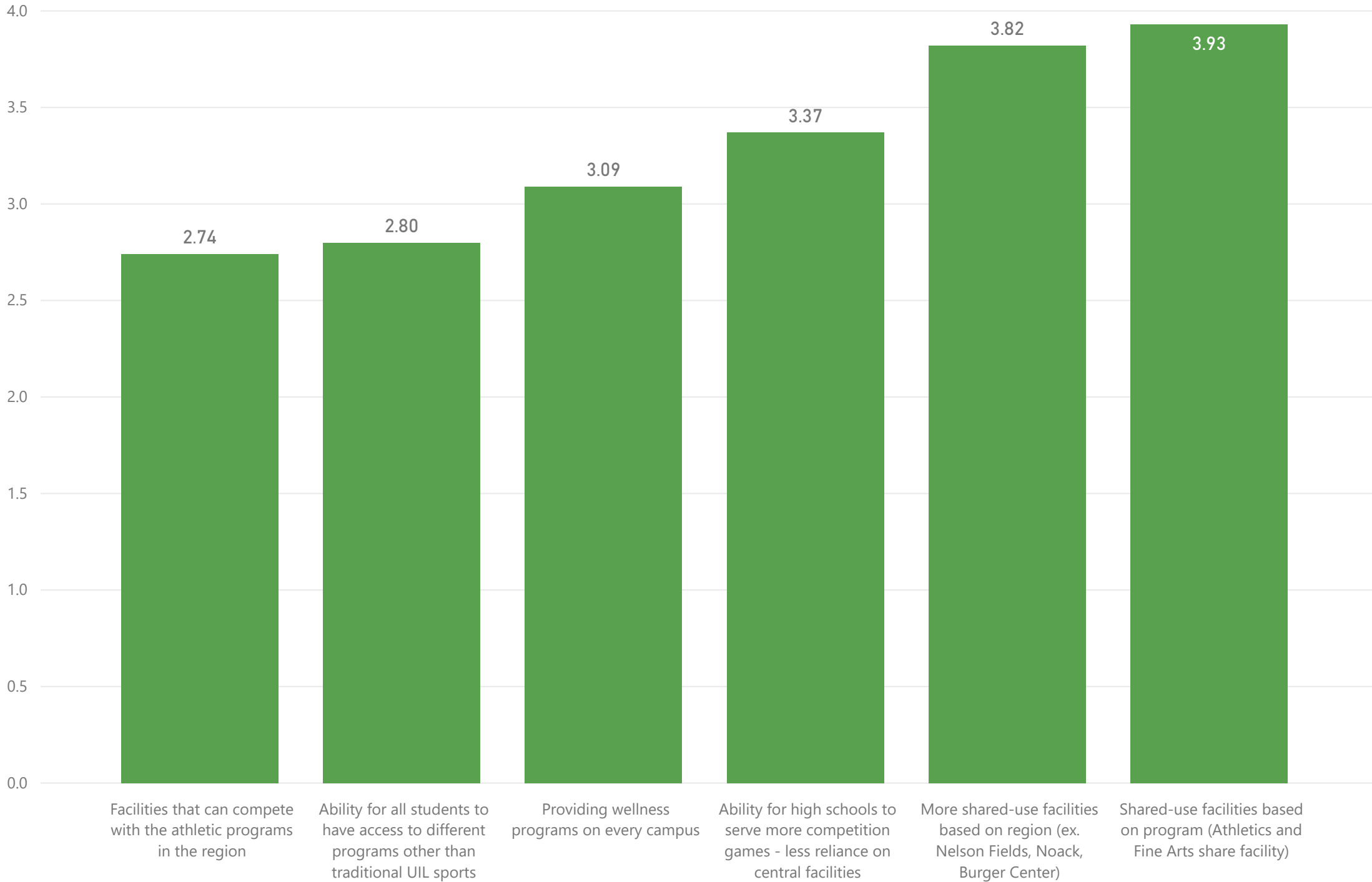

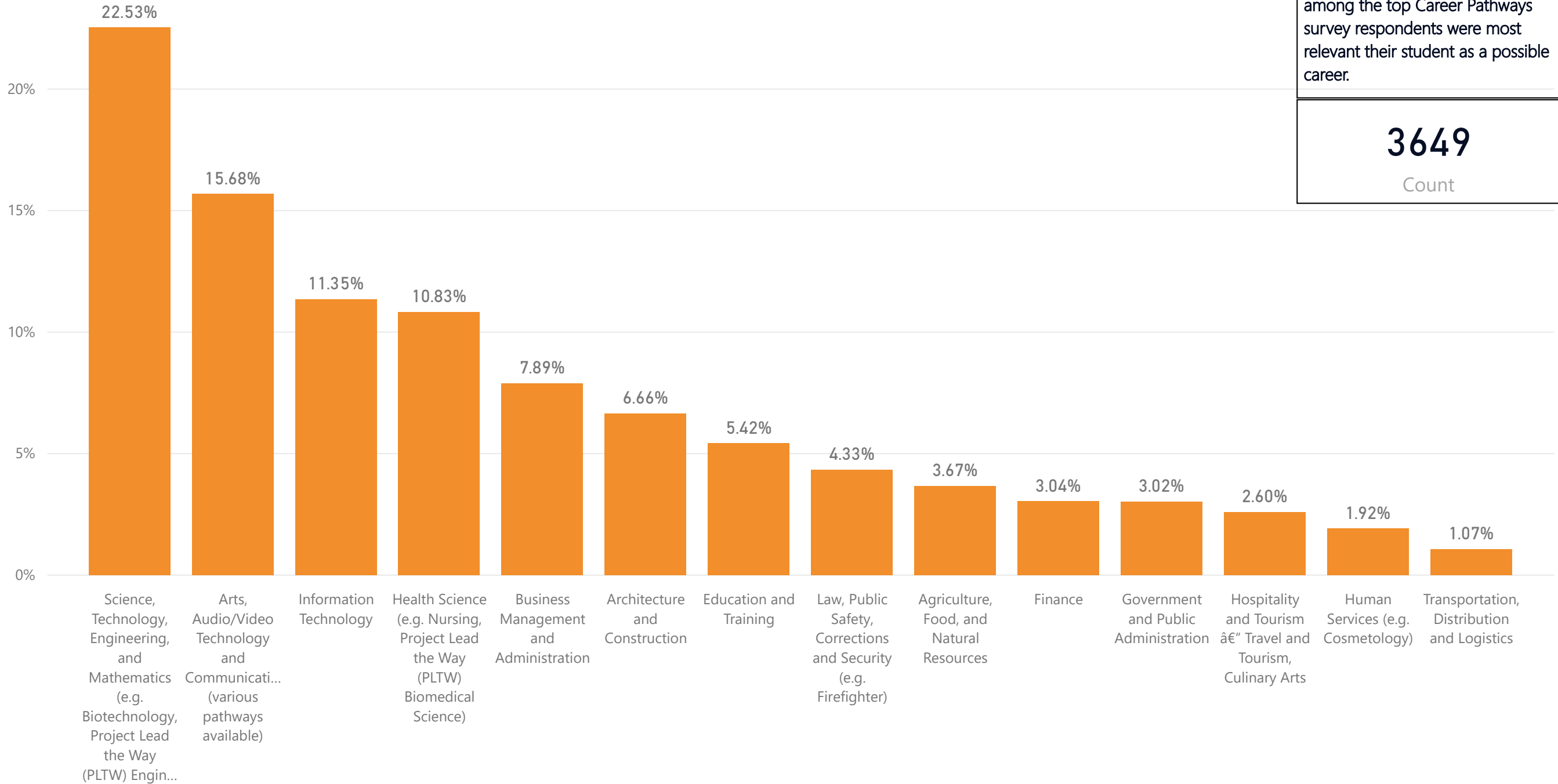

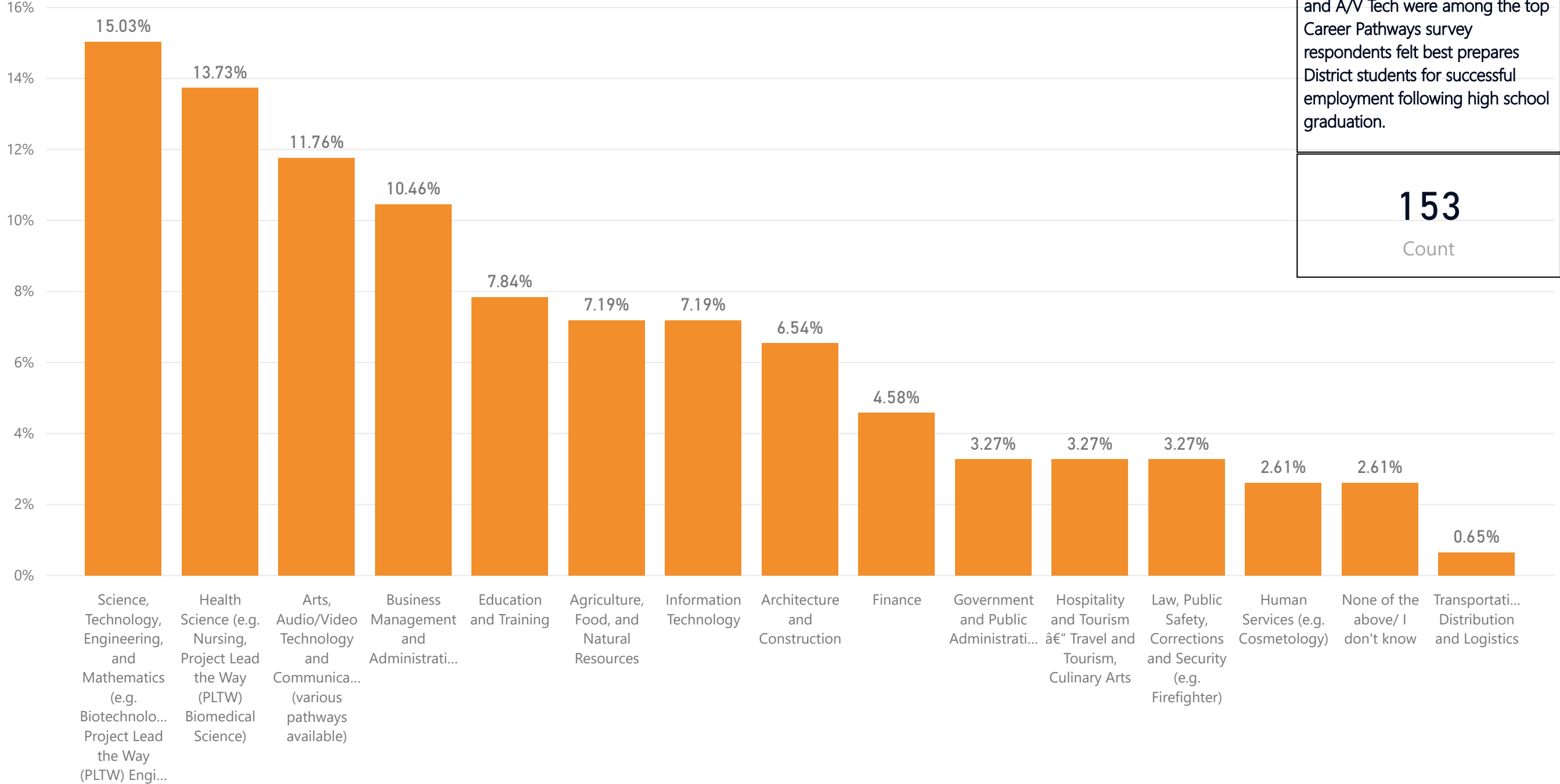

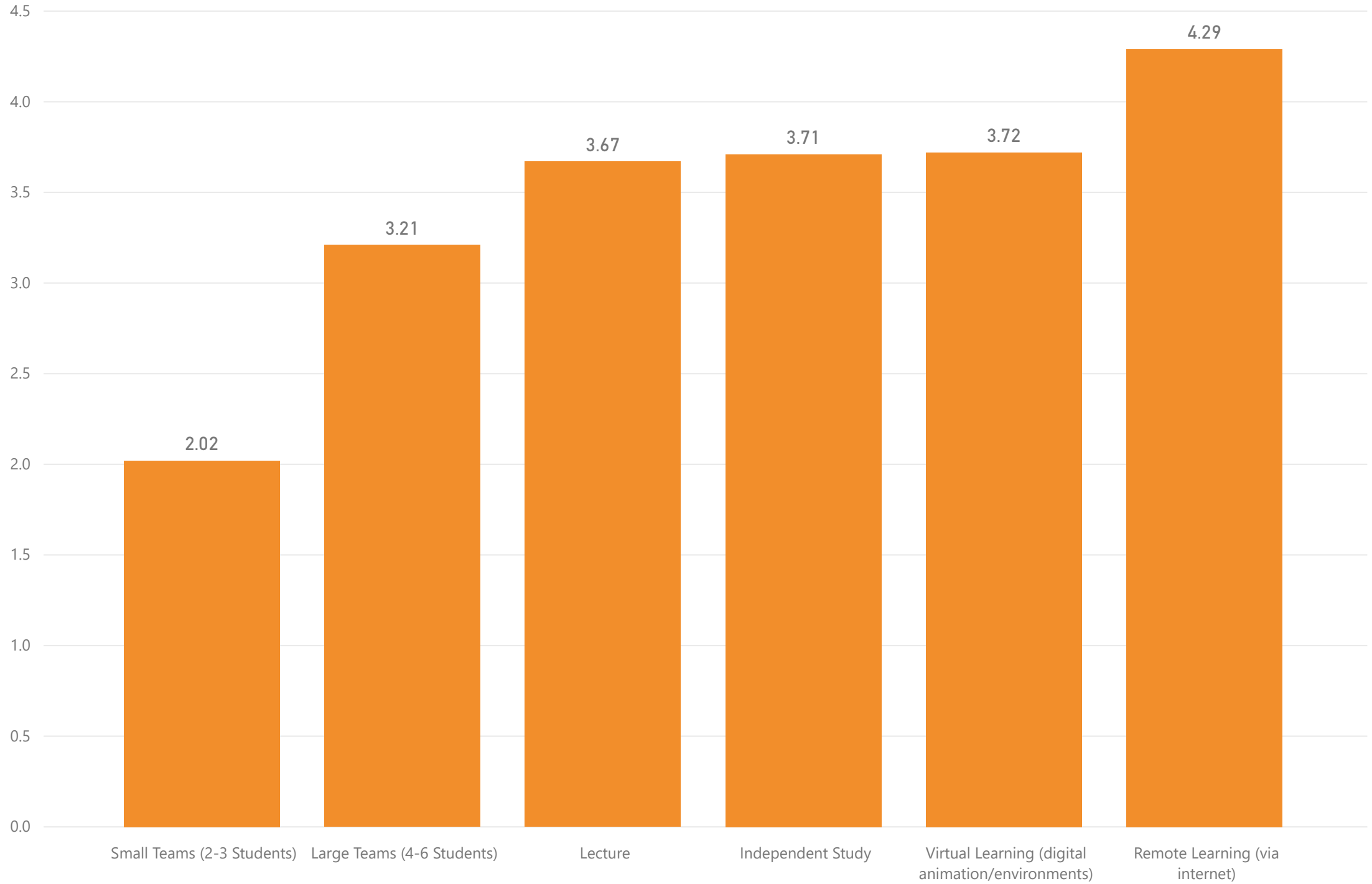


Q5.4 - Please list three words that best describe AISD CTE today:

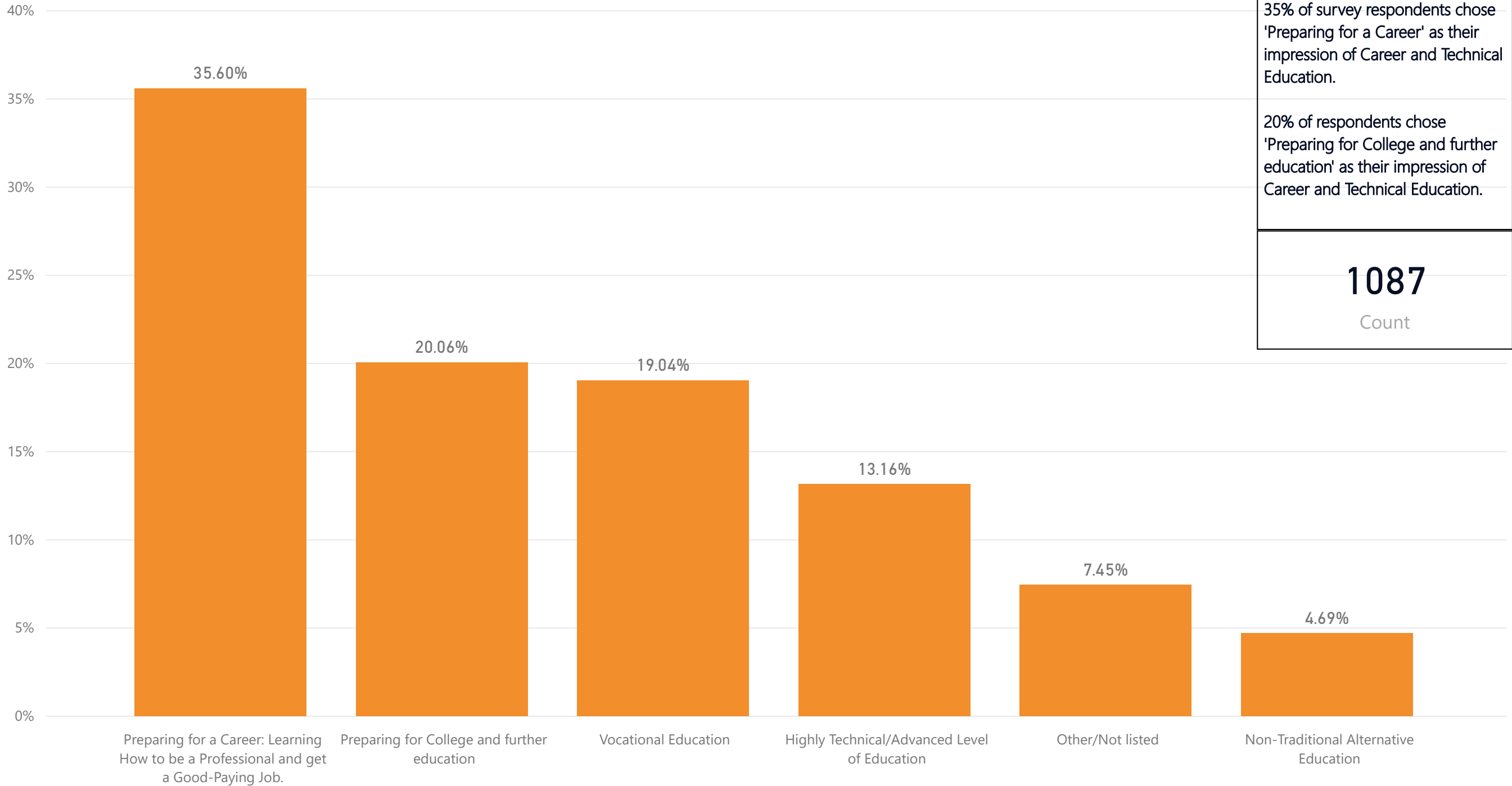

20% of respondents chose 'Preparing for College and further education' as their impression of Career and Technical Education.

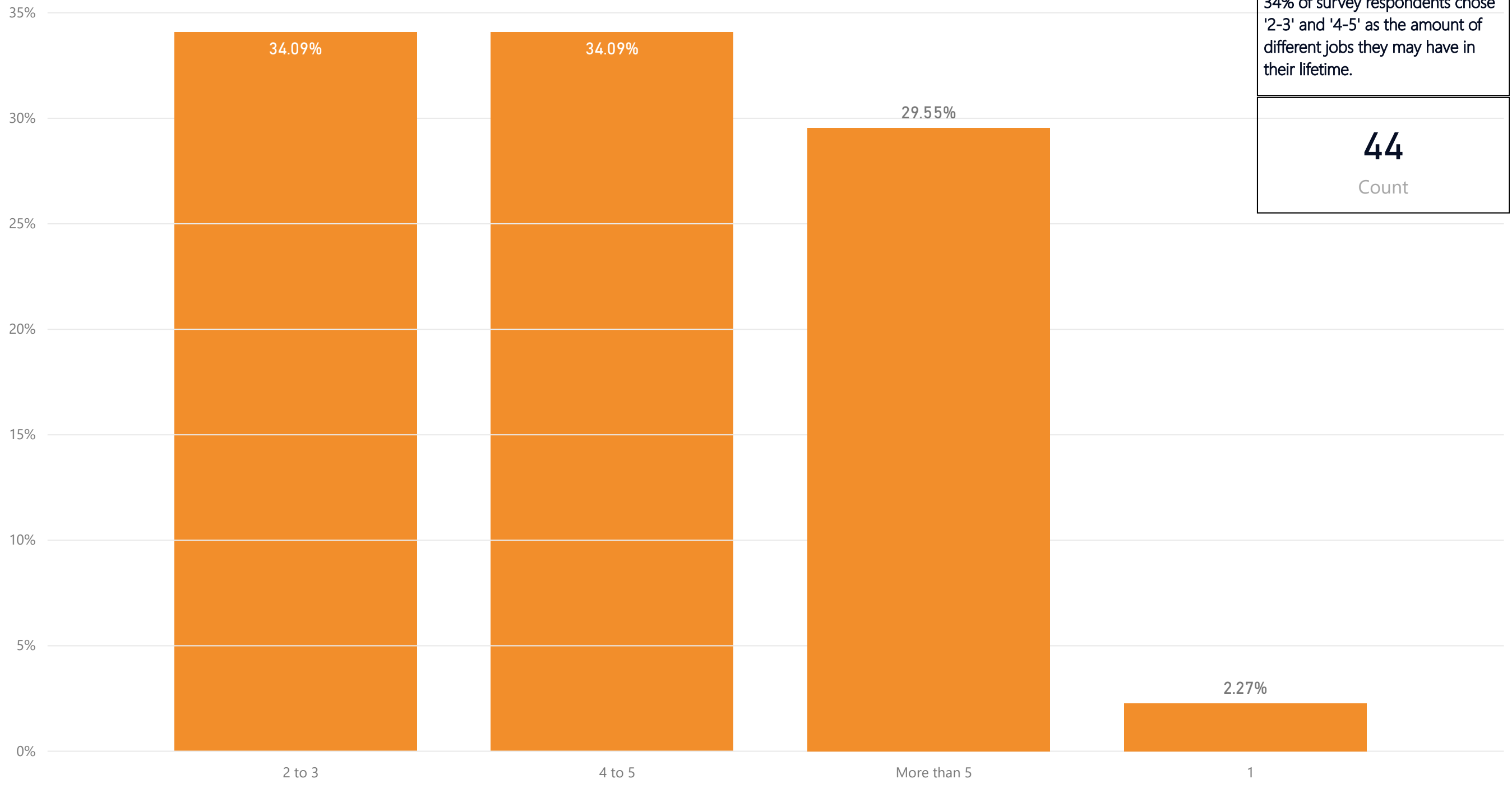

34% of survey respondents chose '2-3' and '4-5' as the amount of different jobs they may have in their lifetime.

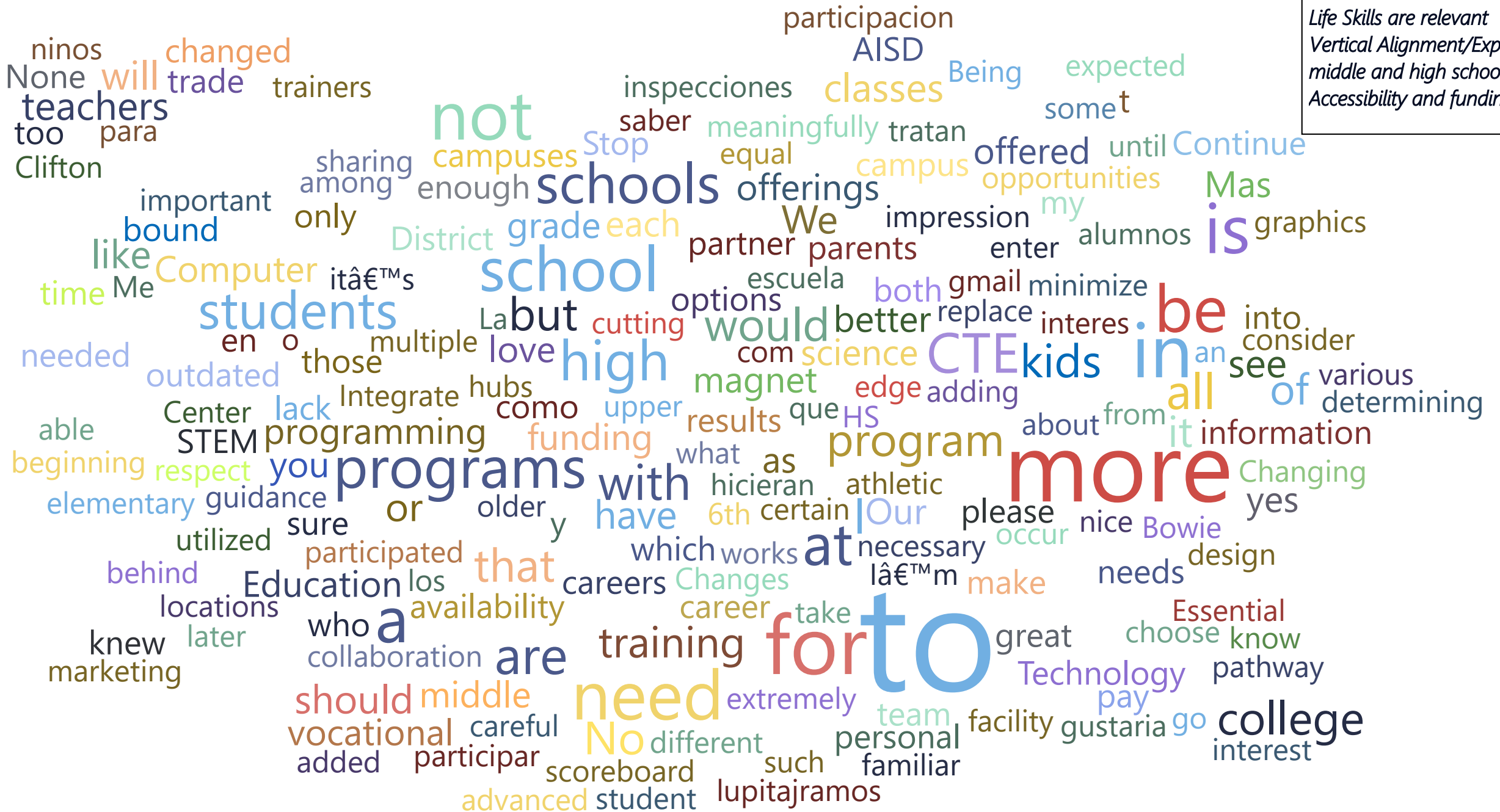

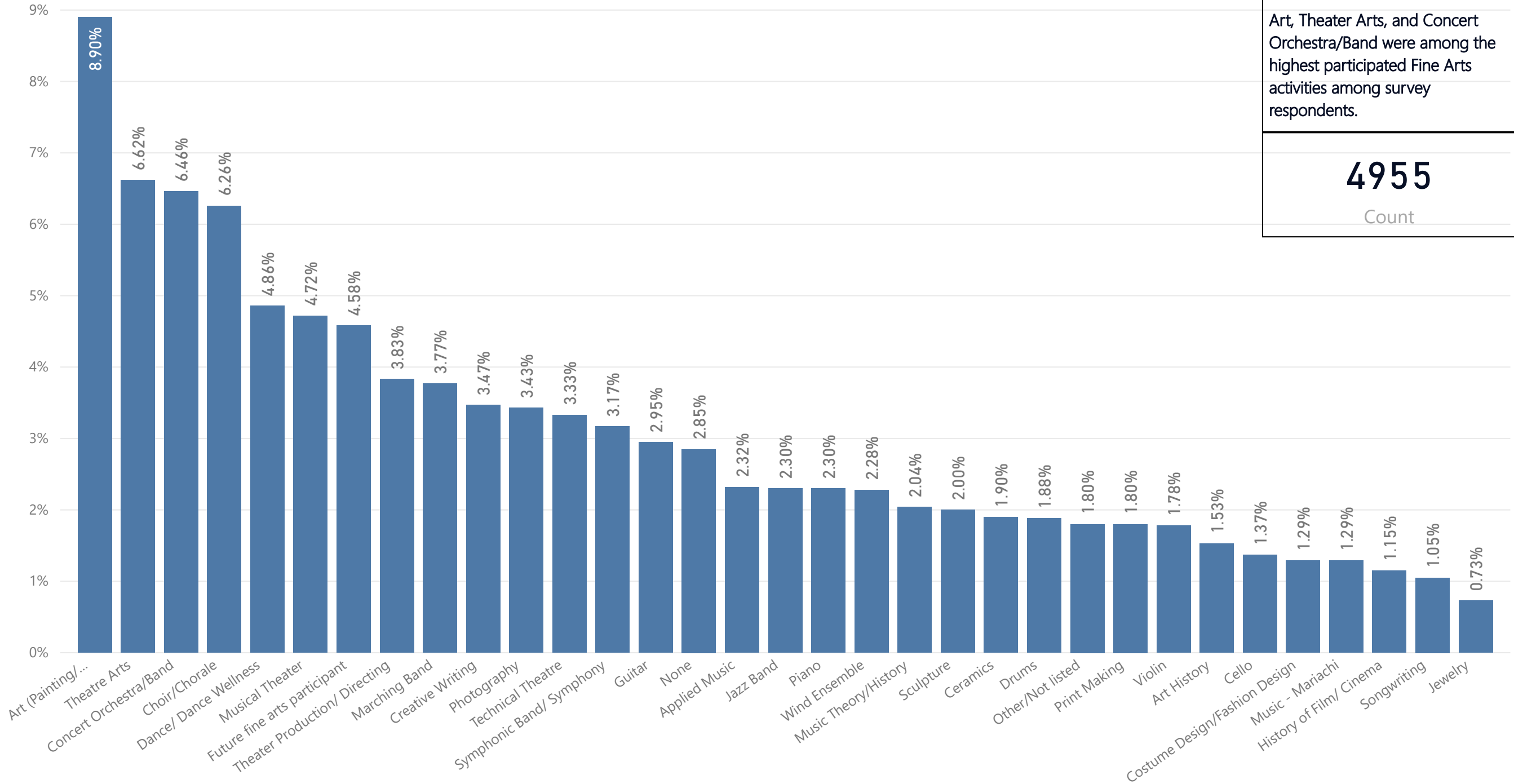


Q8.1 - What fine arts (visual and performing arts) activities are you participating in, attending, or supporting that are currently offered within AISD?

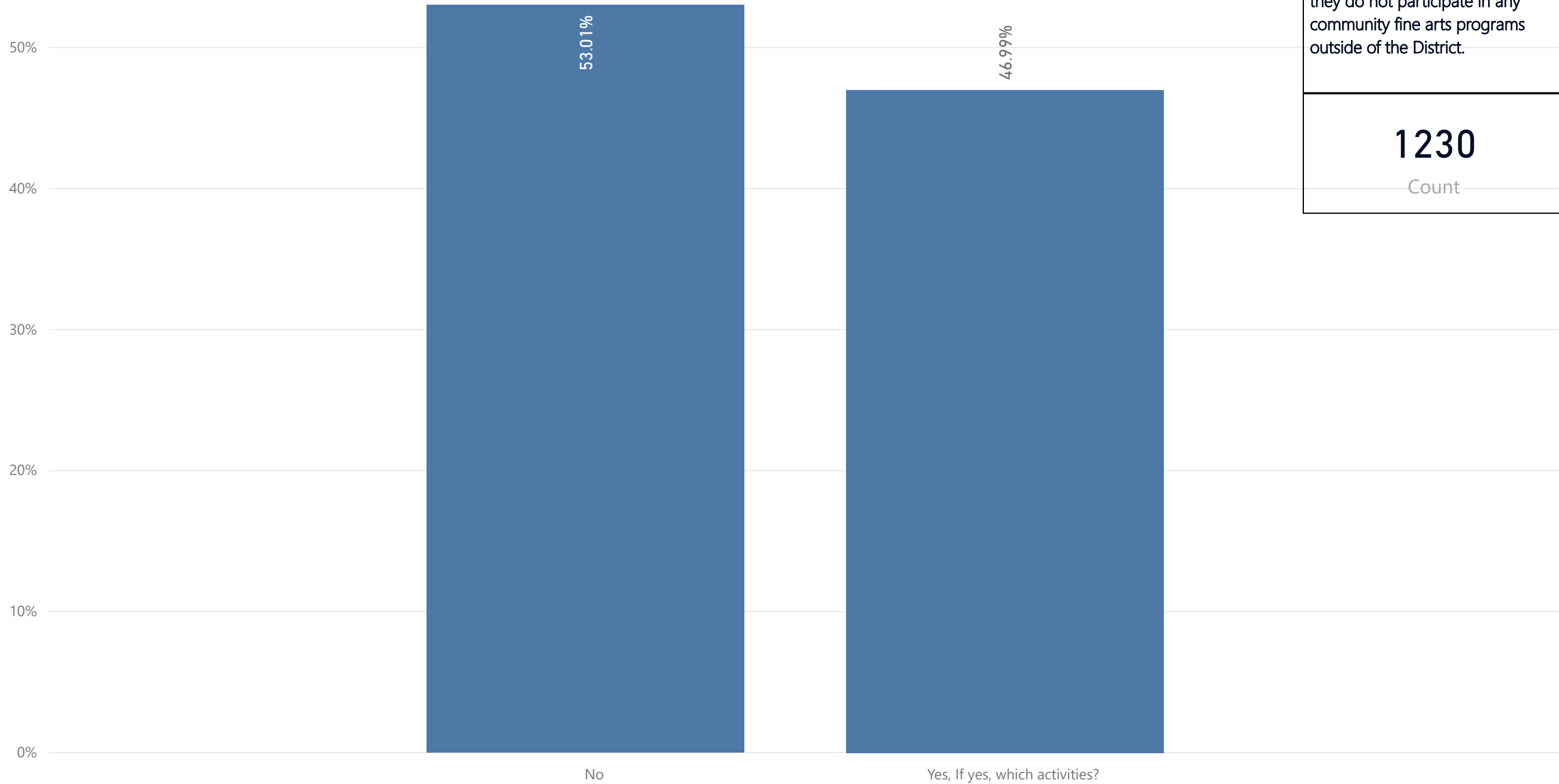
Q8.2 Do you / your child participate in any community fine arts programs or classes outside of AISD?

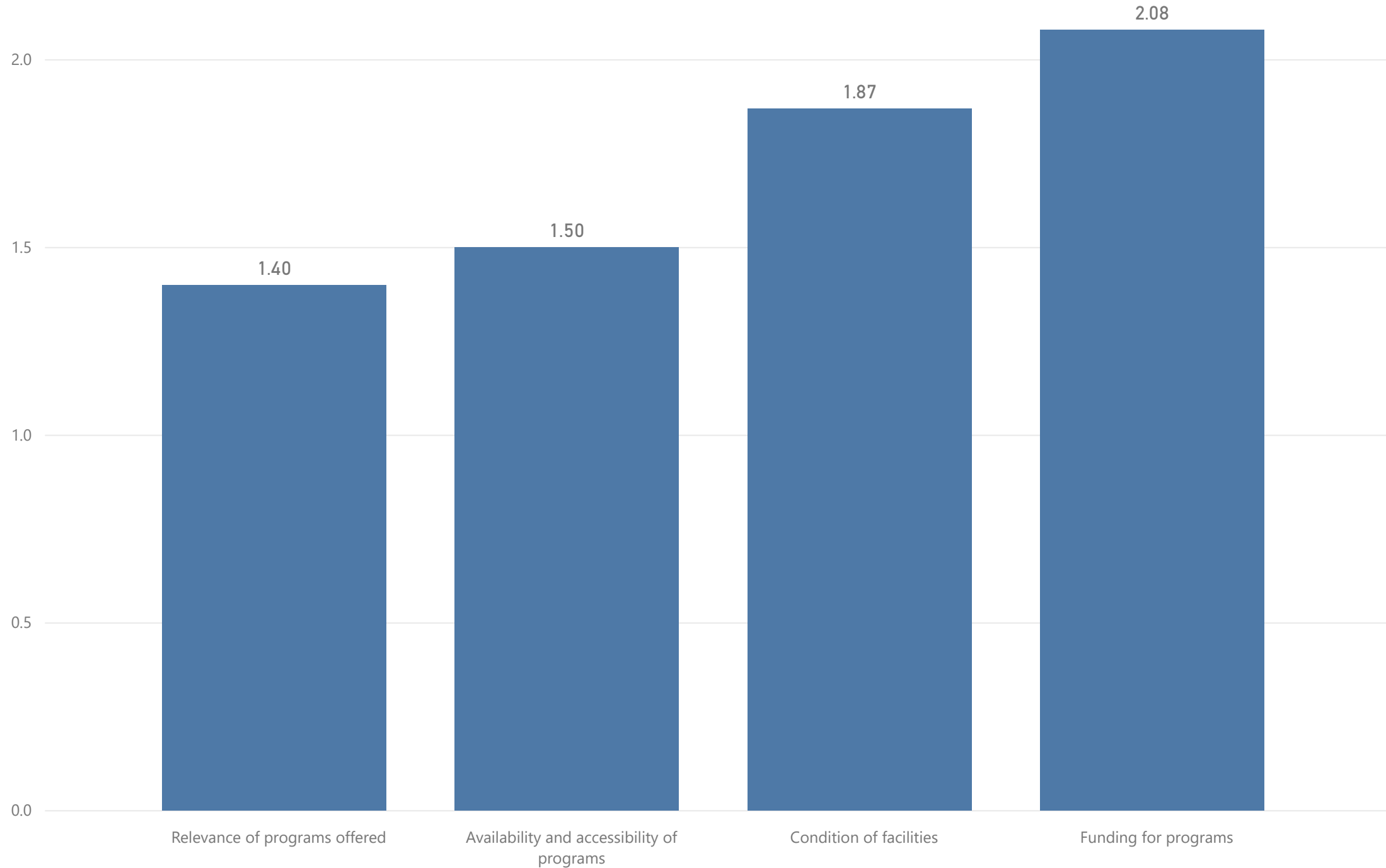

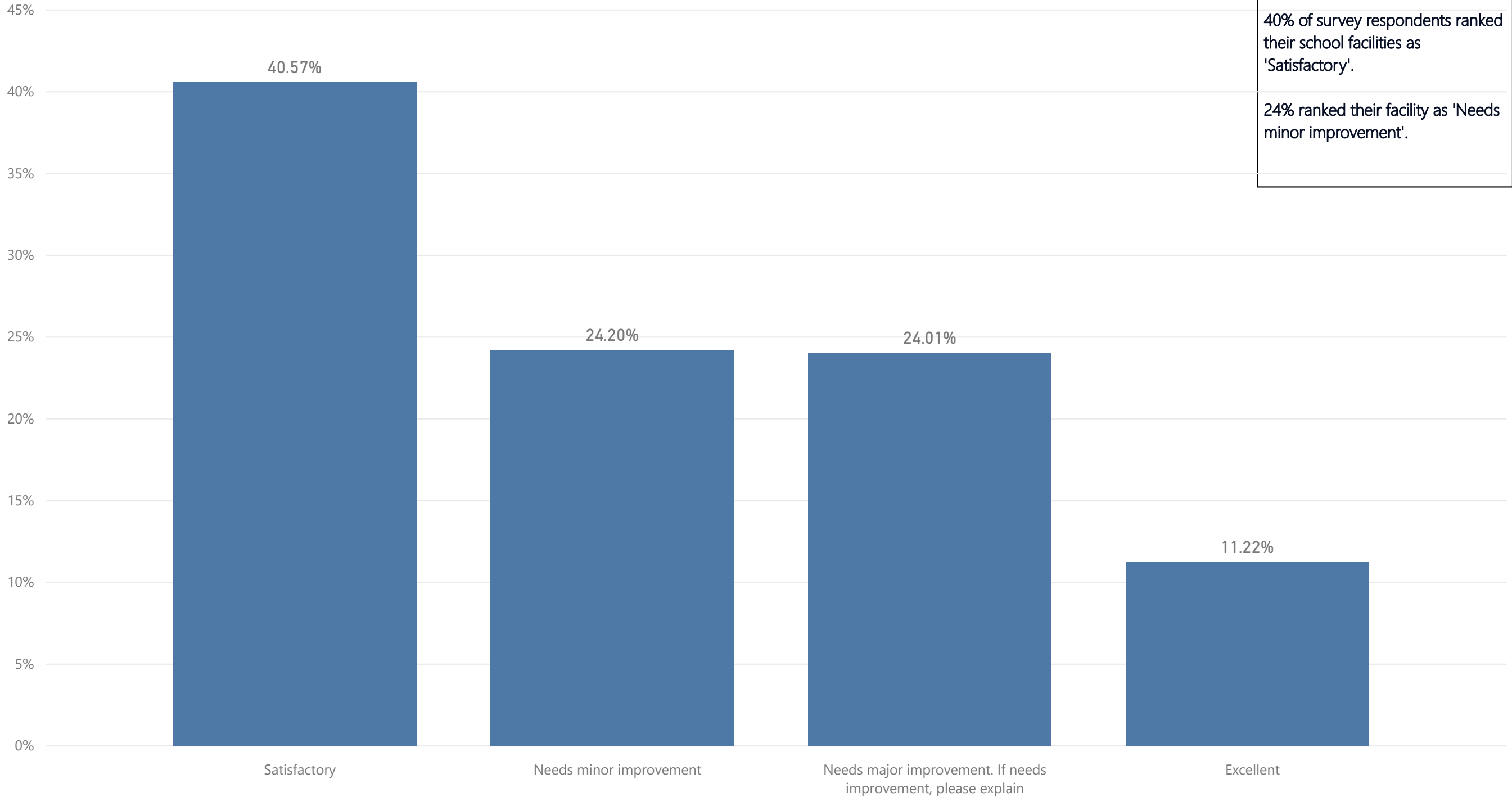

Q8.7 - What is your opinion about the condition of the current AISD Fine Arts facilities at the Performing Arts Center (PAC) ?

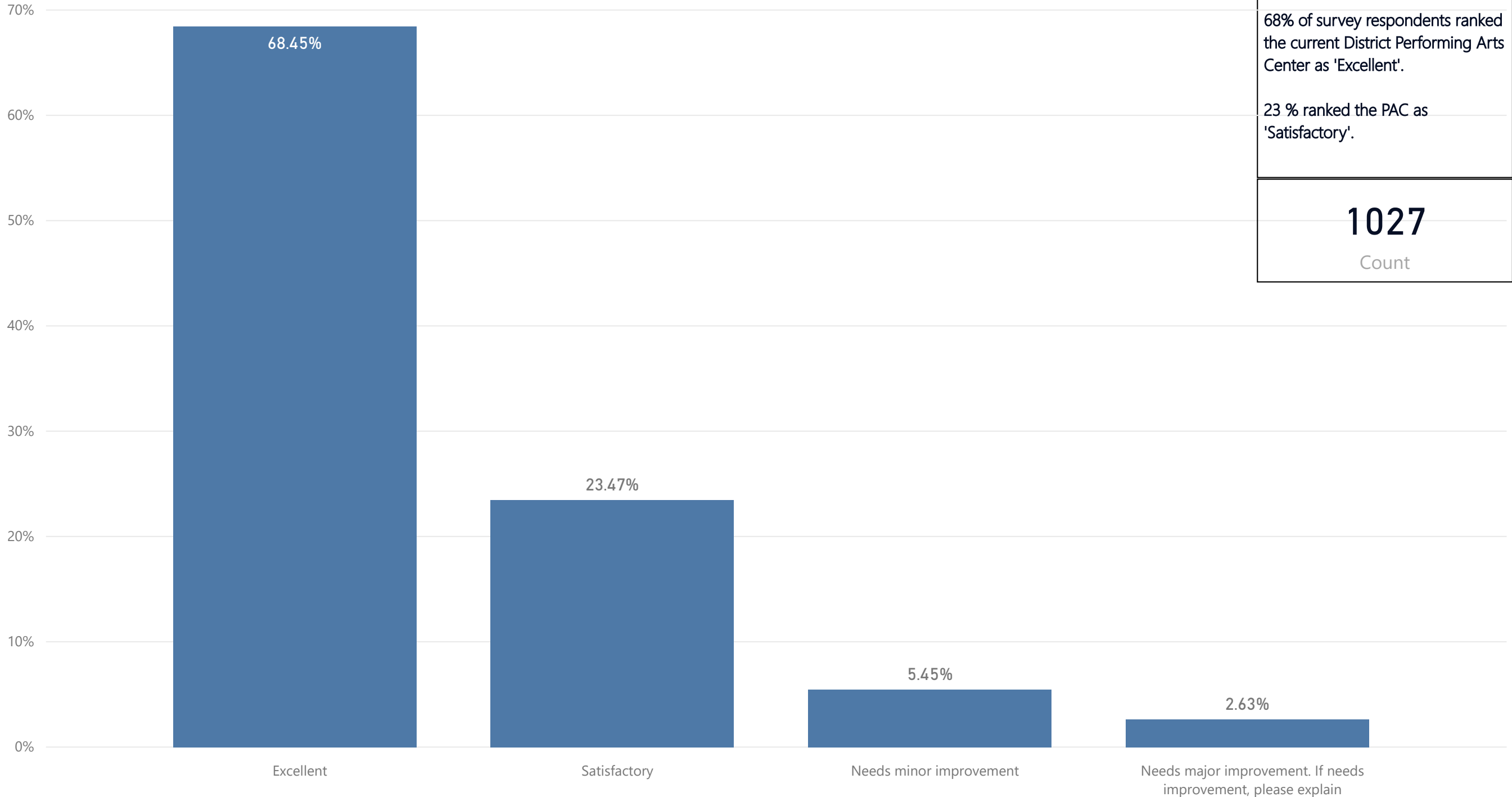

Q8.8 - What is your opinion about the availability of the current AISD fine arts supplies and equipment?

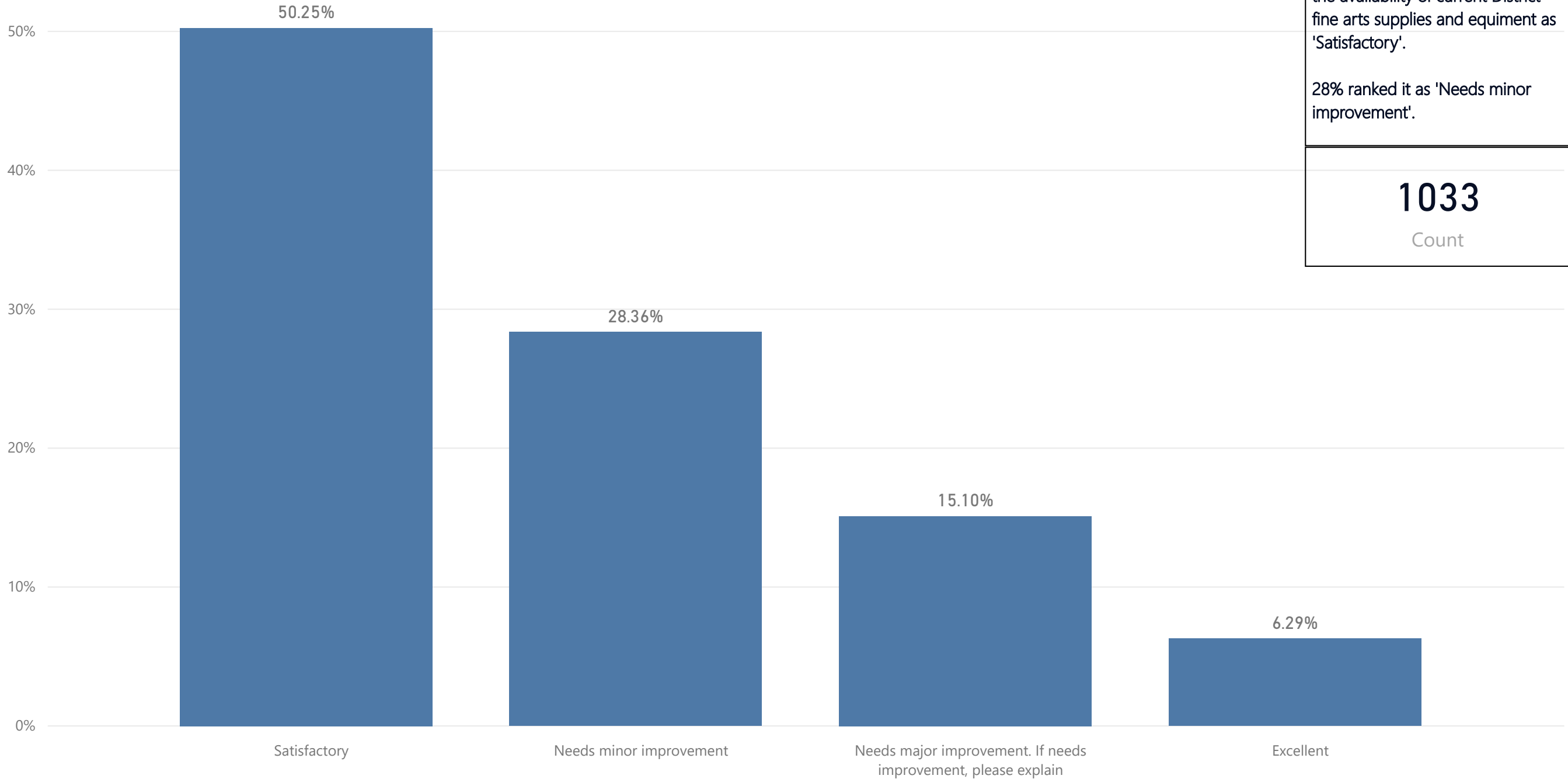

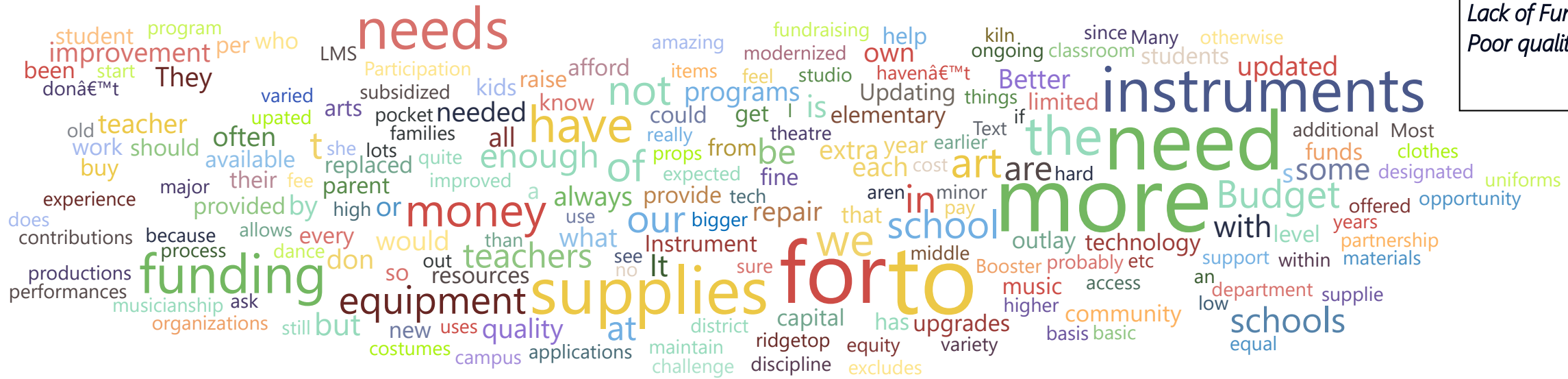

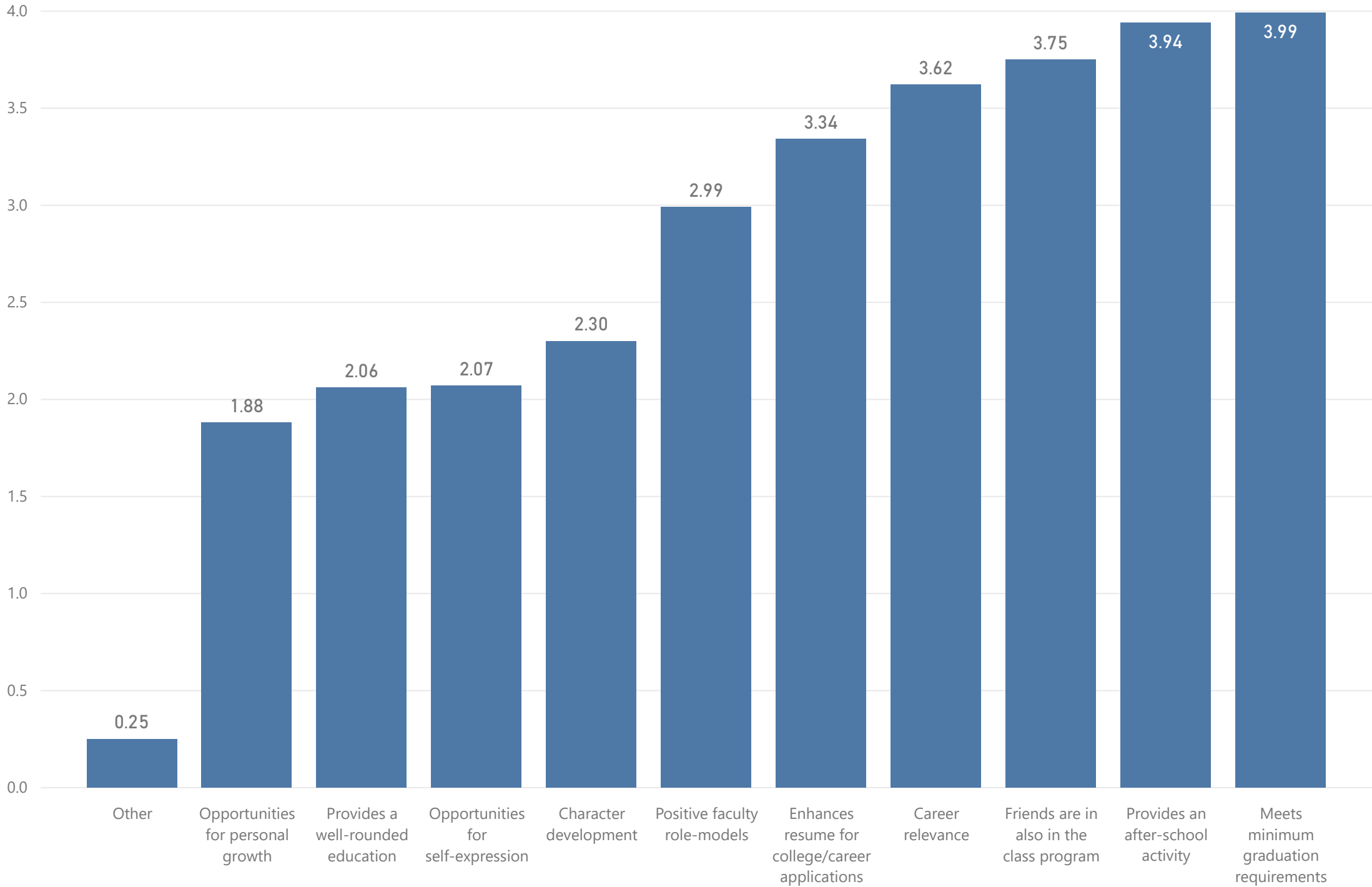

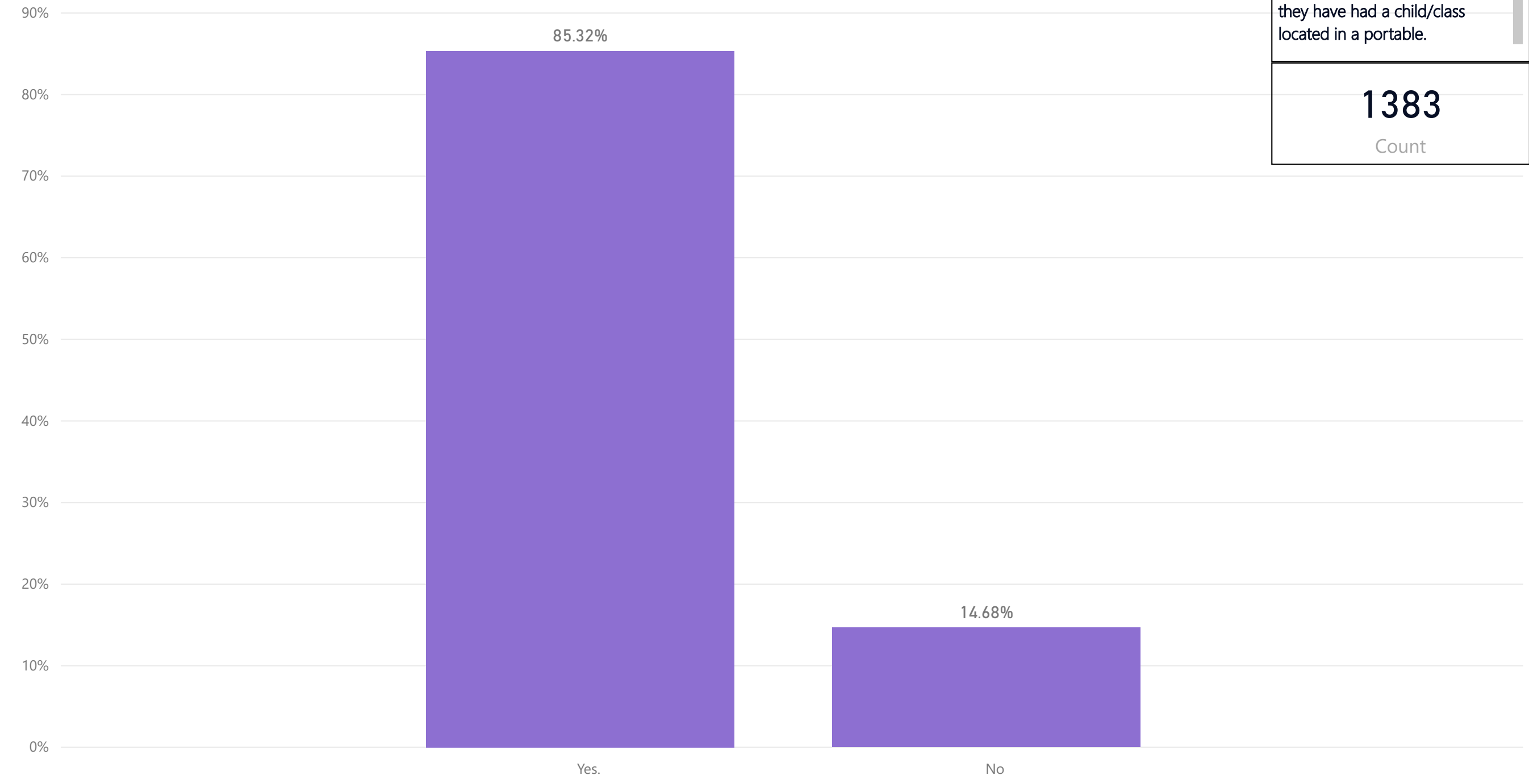

Q9.2 - How important is it for AISD to reduce the number of portable classrooms at the school(s) you are most closely affiliated with?

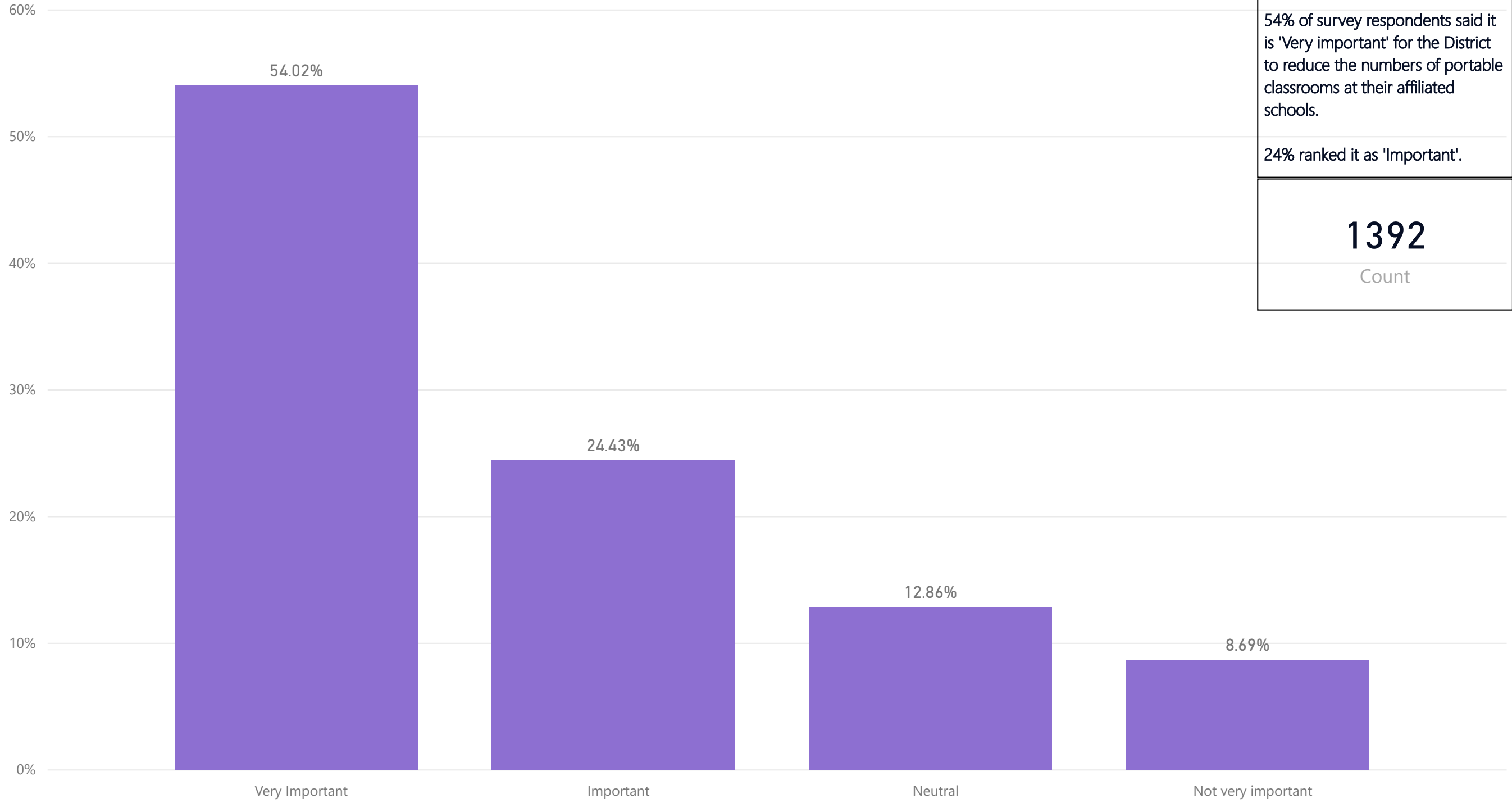
Summary:
