  - Question: Is this for English speakers who are acquiring another language? No
  - Two versions English language development and Dual Language. Each has a Middle School and high school version.

6:27 Cont'd - Guest Speaker: Student Services- Common Application process - Gabe Reyes Director of Enrollment and Attendance Services

- The Common App process is new and it allows us to track students to see when they apply for the program and go through and accept students.
- Lotteries were designed for campuses who had several applicants
- Campuses will manage waitlist
- The long range planning and the Equity committee both have student access committees
- Questions:
  - Do we have a timeline for Enroll Austin? Next year is the roll out and will affect 24-25 SY
  - Are there any weights currently in the lotteries to ensure access to underserved student groups? Not in the current lottery
  - I've noticed an ability to accept two different programs at two different schools today once one clicks Family Choice. Why is this? Sometimes students will get admitted to more than one program and different schools. Parents can choose which program will best fit their child. Once the parent chooses, it'll assign them to their school for the next school year
  - Follow up on the weights in lottery: Is that something that the new program can do? Yes, Enroll Austin will have the ability to designate priorities.
  - Are heritage speakers set as a priority in the DL lottery system? Need to go back and look at that
  - Can the MEAC be provided with a list of the priorities that will be built into the system? They will be a part of this process and as we go through the process we've gotten public input. We're in development from now through the summer. They will be shared with the public.
  - Does the common app show the transportation that will come with the program?
    Currently with this system it does not but the other program we are building will along with other features to help them make the best decision

  - Question: What is ALCA? Advanced Language & Career Applications
  - Are there currently any high school students from different campus taking ALCA at a certain campus? No, currently some campuses have not offered ALCA and have found creative ways to support students.
