In keeping with Austin ISD Board Policy EHAA, the Human Sexuality and Responsibility (HSR) curriculum will be taught this fall during your child's health class. The 9 lessons cover developmentally and age-appropriate information related to dating and romantic relationships, trafficking and online safety, reproductive anatomy and pregnancy, parenting and paternity, boundaries and abstinence, sexual health and staying safe, and consent and refusal skills. This curriculum has been established to provide information and skill development for students so that they may reach their highest potential for physical, emotional, mental and social health.
