### **Facility Summary**


Akins Early College High School serves an enrollment of approximately 2,800 students in far south Austin. The school's purpose statement is to graduate all students prepared to be successful in any postsecondary endeavor. The original campus was built in 2000, and stand-alone studio and science additions were added in 2008 and 2010 and consists of approximately 350,000 square feet. Akins is an academy school featuring seven academies that each have 400-500 students. The layout of the teaching spaces in studios is based around these academies.

### Educational Suitability and Facility Condition Assessments - 2021

The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
