Allison Elementary School, serving an enrollment of approximately 400 students in southeast Austin, is known for its diverse curriculum and robust dual-language program. The campus is part of the Eastside Memorial family of schools, which offers "STEAM" programs at every grade level. Originally built in 1955, the campus does not meet many of the current AISD Educational Specifications. Recent modernizations to the campus targeted HVAC, technology, security, civil and structural improvements, while leaving the underlying campus layout intact. The main building plan was very efficiently designed with no space for growth. Many programs including studios and special education programs are currently housed in portables.
