Baldwin Elementary School, serving an enrollment of approximately 675 students in southwest Austin, is a suburban neighborhood school in the Meridian subdivision. It was built in 2010 with a total of 87,000 square feet on 14 acres. The campus grounds are large. There is a covered basketball court adjacent to the indoor gymnasium, and a couple of areas are set up for outdoor classes. The school has cisterns as well as gardens. The school is across the street from the Meridian Community Pavilion.
