Facility Summary

Blackshear Elementary School is in east Austin and serves an enrollment of approximately 380 students. It was originally built in 1903, with two wings added since 1995, and consists of approximately 71,000 square feet. The school is known for being a fine arts academy and a National Blue Ribbon School. It focuses a portion of the school day on core instruction followed by fine arts, with an emphasis in dance. The original building's age creates issues in how the campus can use certain spaces. Studios have been converted to accommodate some of the school's notable programs, including music.

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
