Facility Summary

Govalle Elementary School, serving an enrollment of approximately 370 students, is in east Austin. It was one of the first projects completed as part of the 2017 bond program and fully replaced the old Govalle Elementary School originally built in 1931. The school opened in mid-February 2020. The school offers a wide range of programs, including pre-K, dual language and STEM education. The building is two stories at the classrooms wings, and there is ample access to daylight throughout. The school has a generous collection of learning spaces, from appropriately sized studios to small group rooms and flexible learning spaces, all meeting the district's Educational Specifications.



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
