Houston Elementary School has an enrollment of approximately 430 students in southeast Austin for pre-K through fifth grade. The campus offers tuition-assisted pre-K to qualified families. The campus was originally built in 1976 and separate additions were built in 1991 and 2006. It offers signature programs such as a certified academic language therapist, dual language: one-way Spanish, and social and emotional learning. The campus consists of multiple detached buildings on approximately 13 acres. The main building houses the library, cafeteria, art room and the majority of learning spaces.


