### **Facility Summary**


Linder Elementary School serves an enrollment of approximately 400 students in south Austin. It was built in 1972, with a music building addition in 2008, and consists of approximately 70,000 square feet on 10 acres. The main building is a single level, and the studio wings are connected by a central library and administration. The cafeteria and gym can be accessed after-hours and closed off from the rest of the school. The general appearance of the building is dated, and the interior feels relatively dark due to small openings to the outside.

### Educational Suitability and Facility Condition Assessments -2021

The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
