Facility Summary


Mathews Elementary School, serving an enrollment of approximately 350 students in central Austin, is known as an urban neighborhood school. It was originally built in 1916 and the site is fully integrated into the neighborhood grid. The school received a Texas Historical Medallion in 2006. Due to site constraints, there is no on-site parking, only on-street parking. The building configuration is a two-story facility in a basic "H" form with the playgrounds on the backside of the property.

The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
