
Facility Summary

McCallum High School currently serves an enrollment of approximately 1,830 students in north central Austin. The original campus was built in 1953, with a new stand-alone addition constructed in 2011 to serve the Fine Arts Academy. The campus consists of approximately 216,000 square feet on 31 acres. The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
