### **Facility Summary**


Murchison Middle School, serving a student enrollment of approximately 1,250 students in northwest Austin, is known for its International Baccalaureate Middle Years program as well as being a pathway for multiple CTE programs and Project Lead the Way that can feed into Anderson High School. Through the 2017 bond program, the original campus is getting multiple upgrades and modernizations that include the media center, administrative suite and new teacher Professional Learning Centers (PLCs). A new three-story classroom building was also added.

### Educational Suitability and Facility Condition Assessments - 2021

The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
