

Facility Summary

Oak Hill Elementary School, serving an enrollment of approximately 730 students in southwest Austin, focuses on dual language and social and emotional learning. The original building was built in 1974 and was designed as a completely open floor plan. Although it has been renovated, many of the studios are open to the hallways, and few have access to natural light. The campus grounds are satisfactory. Various nature trails and outdoor programs weave between groves of trees and an ample lawn. Two playgrounds and a covered basketball court give plenty of options for students to play and interact.

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Educational Suitability and Facility Condition Assessments - 2021

The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
