Rodriguez Elementary School, serving an enrollment of approximately 350 students in Southeast Austin, serves pre-K through fifth grade. Pre-K is offered for free for qualified families. The campus was originally built in 1999 with a classroom addition in 2006 and a more recent addition of two multipurpose classrooms. The school is part of the Creative Learning Imitative with fine arts incorporated throughout the curriculum. The campus also focuses on their programs of dual language: one-way Spanish and social and emotional learning.




