
Facility Summary

Travis Heights Elementary School serves an enrollment of approximately 500 students in south Austin. The original building was constructed in 1938 with a gym addition built in 1985 and a classroom building added in 1994. The campus is a beautiful site and has several outdoor learning gardens, playscapes and a chicken coop. There is not a proper bus loop or parent drop-off, so the residential street is used for this purpose during certain hours. The front entry is not accessible from a parking lot but is located directly off the street. Accessibility across campus is a major issue with limited ramps and no elevators. 


Educational Suitability and Facility Condition Assessments - 2021

The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
