Facility Summary


Webb Middle School serves an enrollment of approximately 630 students in the St. Johns neighborhood of Austin. It has a strong fine arts program and has CTE programs in animation, web design and app development. Webb is the only middle school that provides the English Language Development Academy for students who have been in the country less than two years. The original school was built in 1961 and there is a stand-alone fine arts/band hall completed in 2009 with a total of 121,000 square feet.

The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
