Winn Elementary School, serving an enrollment of approximately 230 students in northeast Austin, is known for its parent engagement and PTA program, as well as being the only school in the district where Montessori education is offered. The school was originally built in 1970 with an addition in 1990, in 2007, and a Library in 2017. The school sits on a nearly 10-acre site adjacent to Manor Road, a very busy transportation corridor. The exterior grounds offer areas for outdoor learning and play.


