

Wooldridge Elementary School serves an enrollment of approximately 470 students in north Austin. It was built in 1969, with a classroom addition constructed in 1998, and consists of approximately 70,000 square feet on 12 acres. The population of the school is diverse with students and families that speak over 30 different languages. They support after school programs for students such as Boys and Girls Club, GirlStart, Soccer Club and Tech Club.





The ESA evaluates how well a facility supports teaching and learning using the district's Educational Specifications as the standard. It includes items such as the exterior, general building, security, controllability of lighting, furniture, academic and administrative spaces, and technology.

The FCA evaluates the physical condition of a facility to measure what systems are broken, aging, etc. This includes items such as roofing, heating and air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site drainage, and parking.

Both assessments incorporate data, staff interviews, facility walk-throughs, cost-estimating, and analysis.
