Bowie High School, serving a student enrollment of approximately 2,900 students in southwest Austin, is the largest comprehensive high school in the district. Bowie High School is on a sprawling campus of approximately 60 acres. The agricultural barn is on an additional 7-acre site adjacent to campus. The campus is receiving upgrades from the 2017 bond program, including an addition for athletics, renovation for fine arts, a parking structure, and HVAC and technology improvements.

The original buildings were built in 1988. At 30 years old, the buildings are in average condition, but require upgrades to function adequately if implementing criteria from the current Ed Spec. The studio building is a large H-shape. The interior hallway is very wide with nice daylight but is not conditioned. It is very hot in the summer and cold in the winter. During high humidity events, the concrete floor sweats and creates slipping hazards. There is some flexible furniture within the space for students to meet and work, but it is underutilized due to the lack of weather control. At the center of the H-shape is the library. It is a large space with daylight coming from skylights.

Every studio has access to daylight and generous windows to the exterior; however, all studios are undersized and have limited flexibility in providing different teaching methods. CTE programs are housed throughout the campus – some in the studio building and some in the current "art garage." There is a robust agricultural program. The ag barn is adjacent to campus and is somewhat walkable, but if students are tending animals before or after school, they typically drive.

The main campus courtyard between the studio/cafeteria/administration is a large space and has one of the premier live oak trees in Austin. The courtyard space is well-loved on campus, but shade is only provided by walkways and a few trees. Upgrades to furniture and landscaping could improve this space to be better utilized for outdoor learning and activities.

Interview Overview

The interview took place at Bowie High School. It included Principal Mark Robinson and Assistant Principal Stephanie McGraw in person and a group of personnel, teachers and a CTE instructor joining by phone. After the interview, Principal Robinson walked the assessment team around the school to point out many of the deficiencies discussed in the meeting.


The group highlighted the courtyard and its trees as one aspect of the campus that should be kept the same. The campus also has a Memorial Garden that should never change.

The group highlighted the inadequacy of the teaching spaces and the limited collaboration/common spaces. There are not enough meeting spaces on campus. Certain teachers try to use the hallway space, but the lack of climate control makes this difficult. The acoustics of this large concrete space are very problematic. There are supplemental programs, such as counseling, speech and OT/PT, that

are not housed in adequate spaces and some are even using closets. There are four Life Skills units, and only two share access to an accessible toilet/shower. CTE spaces also require upgrades, and the wish list of programs includes a greenhouse for agriculture, broadcast or film program with connections to SXSW, an upgraded engineering space, and a more visitor-friendly entrance to the culinary dining space. It was also requested that the library be reimagined to reflect the current educational world and 21st century learning.



The school has a strong sense of community, but the group feels that the learning spaces on campus do not facilitate or stimulate creativity or collaboration. They say they are achieving community despite many deficiencies in the building. There is not a large enough meeting space to house all 200+ faculty/staff members. After the addition of the new auditorium this should be a possibility, but in the past, they have held meetings off campus at the Wildflower Center or the Austin Public Library.

While the upgrades to athletics and fine arts will alleviate some of the issues on campus, such as hosting programs out of portables, the studio wing will still face issues in facilitating the look and feel of a 21st century learning environment.

Assessment Findings

The Educational Suitability Assessment of Bowie High School earned a 62% overall score and places the campus in a category of Average. The assessment consists of seven General Building categories and eight Academic categories to determine areas that need more attention.

Very Unsatisfactory Categories (0-35%):

Academics & Learning

Score is very unsatisfactory.

Studios are generally undersized per Ed Spec. Casework storage is inadequate and inconsistent. Learning spaces need modernization, updated technology, more flexible furniture, and support for small group and individual breakout spaces to meet current Ed Spec standards. Life skills/special education do not have access to needed support spaces.

Unsatisfactory Categories (36-50%):

Security

Score is unsatisfactory.

Score is unsatisfactory.

Cafeteria is too small for student enrollment. There are opportunities to sit in large corridors and in courtyard, but dedicated cafeteria space is not adequate. Cafeteria flooring is tiered. While it is accessible, it is inflexible for configuring different types of cafeteria seating.

Average Categories (51-65%):

General Building

Score is average.

Building is dated but in good condition. There is peeling paint in some studios. Site has beautiful trees at entry and parts of the campus feel welcoming. Covered walkways throughout campus create a nice user experience. Athletics and fine arts can be accessed from the rest of campus for events, but the library cannot. There is no dedicated community room.

Controllability of Systems

Score is average.

Blinds are in poor condition. Thermostats are present in rooms, but many are not functioning.

Furniture, Fixtures, Equipment

Score is average.

There is a mixture of furniture – some newer, more flexible furniture in library, robotics labs and other spaces – but other spaces have outdated, heavy, poor-condition furniture. Some outdoor furniture and hallway lockers are in poor condition.

Media Resources

Score is average.

The library has adequate size and space overall, but it is in the interior of academic wing and cannot be partitioned off easily from rest of school. The large space has acoustic issues of sound carrying throughout the library. There is not a variety of seating for independent or group study. Breakout/storage rooms are being used by Vida Clinic, taking up support space for the library.

Technology

Score is average.

There are new edu-display boards in all studios and some projectors, but all studios still have chalkboards, no whiteboards. There is inadequate access to electrical outlets throughout studios.

Administration Spaces

Score is average.

The space has a low ceiling and does not feel welcoming. Conference room for PTSA/visitors is close to the entry, but there is no transparency into the space.

Satisfactory Categories (66-80%):

Exterior

Score is satisfactory.

Site has adequate signage and clear flow of traffic to entry points. Dumpster area is barrier free.

Outdoor Learning and Activity

Score is satisfactory.

Outdoor courtyards and central courtyard could be used for outdoor learning if supported adequately with technology and comfortable, flexible furniture. Greenhouses are in poor condition and not functioning. There is no dedicated garden elsewhere on campus.

Environmental Quality

Score is satisfactory.

Natural light is provided in all studios and hallways. Cracked concrete floors, and bats have been noted as issues.

CTE and Career Connected Learning

Score is satisfactory.

There is a large agriculture program and farm adjacent to campus. The high school offers almost all CTE programs, including a strong culinary arts program with supporting facilities. Some CTE courses are being taught in typical studios without specialized facilities.

Very Satisfactory Categories (81-100%):

Visual and Performing Arts

Score is very satisfactory.

New auditorium and fine arts wing are under construction. Some existing programs are taking over renovated space in the old wing as a result, such as dance. Most spaces are in good shape. Some additional storage per Ed Spec is missing (dance, percussion).

Athletics and Wellness

Score is very satisfactory.

New athletics wing with gym and locker facilities/storage is under construction. Old gym spaces are being renovated for fine arts and dance. Field and tracks are not receiving upgrades. There are some practice fields across Slaughter Lane. Softball field is far from parking.



The heart of the campus is the large courtyard, complete with mature oak trees that provide shade. It is surrounded by covered walkways. The space needs access to electricity, more reliable Wi-Fi, and flexible furniture to become more useful for outdoor learning and activities.




One courtyard in the academic wing contains a solar studio and an outdoor theater. Some trees are mature and provide shade, but more shade (and technological support) is required in all courtyards.




Campus has a new parking garage that recently opened. Eight new tennis courts are on upper level of garage. Site circulation has been updated to accommodate its opening.



Generously wide hallways in academic wing have ample natural light. Atrium layout provides informal connection between levels. Hallway is unconditioned and cannot be used as collaboration space during many months of the year.

Natural light is abundant, but blinds are in poor shape. There is inadequate storage space. Light shelves (bulkhead over lower windows) have been repurposed for storage. Tech/computer studios do not have adequate electrical outlet access, creating potential tripping hazards with cords.

Informal collaboration furniture in unconditioned hallway is dated and does not provide power.



Agriculture barn is adjacent to campus. Mixture of corrugated metal pens for animals and existing barn with no accommodations for providing courses at the ag barn. All ag courses are taught in studio building on campus.



A few dedicated teaching spaces in the academic wing are incredibly narrow. Some have served in the past as conference rooms.



Life Skills: Two studios share a small kitchen and have a washer/dryer and an accessible restroom but are in poor condition without adequate storage. Appliances need updating. Two life skills studios do not have direct access to a restroom, washer/dryer or kitchen.
