Travis Early College High School serves an enrollment of approximately 1,300 students (combined with Graduation Preparatory Academy housed at this campus) in south Austin. The school's purpose statement is to graduate all students prepared to be successful in any postsecondary endeavor. The original campus was built in 1953, with a series of additions since its original construction. Parts of the school are two stories, and the athletic program is in a separate building behind the main campus. The track and practice fields are behind the athletic building.

It is difficult to navigate the campus due to the multiple additions. The cafeteria is off the main entrance to the campus and has a stage. The auditorium is able to be accessed after-hours and is located toward the back of the main building. The auditorium is in good condition and has ample stage space. The studios have the connected desk/chair configuration, making reconfiguration a challenge. The studios appear small but have adequate artificial and natural lighting.

The athletic building is located toward the back of the campus and was receiving roof work during our assessment. There are inadequacies in the small gym that does not allow for proper practice. The dance/cheerleading space is generous and has the appropriate supporting program spaces. The weight room is in an existing warehouse. It does not have proper ventilation, nor does it have the proper support programs such as restrooms and storage.

#### **Interview Overview**

This interview was held virtually, but on-site, and we were joined by Principal Hantgin and staff from a few departments. The attendees told us that Travis ECHS has a rich history and through the years has undergone changes that have both benefited and disadvantaged the campus. Their specialized CTE programs have become a model for other campuses across the district and the staff aims to keep Travis ECHS on the forefront of learning.

The pieces of the campus that staff feel are important to the school's image are the wood front doors, which are original to the building; the tower in the back, which was attached to the original boiler house; and the veterans memorial at the front of the campus.

Many programs are not in suitable spaces, including those in portables or in disconnected buildings. Life skills and the Delta Lab are in portables, and the weight room is in a stand-alone building purchased from an auto shop. The athletics director voiced concern for the small size of the auxiliary gym as well as the lack of seating on both sides of the main competition gym. Their popular photography class is held in a space that can only hold 16 students, and the black box studio is in a nonspecialized room that has been painted black to create a more realistic environment. The staff mentioned the need for large and flexible spaces for collaboration that have appropriate technology connections. Science labs need renovations to function properly as some of the utility hookups do not

work (Bunsen burners, sinks, etc.), and the restrooms in the weight room do not work. Additional needed spaces include space for admin files, general storage areas, and dressing rooms for band and CTE programs.

The principal talked about the wish of having an HVAC program on the campus. They do not currently have the proper facilities to support this program. In thinking 20 years from now, staff would like to see an indoor turf facility for the athletics department and more seating in the main gym and lower competition fields. They would like to see collaboration spaces with flexible and adaptable furniture as well as technology connections. They would also like to have an on-campus swimming facility. Other requested updates to infrastructure include: an efficient HVAC system and more modern water fountains with bottle fill stations. Travis ECHS utilizes outdoor spaces for learning, but they do not have proper outdoor studios. Outdoor furniture, shade coverage and proper connections for technology would help create more engaging learning spaces.

#### **Assessment Findings**

The Educational Suitability Assessment of Travis ECHS earned a 60% overall score and places the campus in a category of Average. The assessment consists of seven General Building categories and eight Academic categories to determine areas that need more attention.

#### Unsatisfactory Categories (36-50%):

#### Security

Score is unsatisfactory.

#### **Controllability of Systems**

Score is unsatisfactory.

There is only a single switch on/off for lights. All studios have mini blinds that are in average shape. Not all studios have a thermostat.

#### **Academic & Learning**

Score is unsatisfactory.

Studios are undersized, averaging around 730 square feet. Science labs are adequately sized. The school does not have any professional learning centers for instructors, and there are no group, small group, or individual study spaces throughout the studio wings.

#### **Administration Spaces**

Score is unsatisfactory. The administration spaces are separated by a main hallway. There is no visual connection to the main

entrance, and the reception area is not welcoming.

#### Average Categories (51-65%):

#### Exterior

Score is average.

There is adequate separation of bus pickup/drop-off and student traffic. All three dumpsters (trash, recycling, compost) are present; however, the route has some barriers such as steps and a long pathway.

#### **General Building**

Score is average.

The hallways are generous and over 10 feet in width. The school does not have a community room. Gymnasium and auditorium can all be opened separately after-hours. The general appearance of the school is good.

#### Environmental Quality

Score is average.

All studios have access to natural daylight and views outside. The weight room is in existing warehouse and does not have adequate support programs. The school has had rat issues in the past.

#### Furniture, Fixtures, Equipment

Score is average.

Furniture is in average condition and ergonomic/sized appropriately for grade level. The library has different configurations of furniture to accommodate group sizes. Most classes have the combined seat and desktop making it difficult to rearrange in group settings.

#### **Athletics and Wellness**

Score is average.

The gym/auxiliary gym are adequately sized but all portions of athletics are dated. The size of the auxiliary gym does not allow for proper practice given its size. The weight room is in existing warehouse and disconnected from the athletic building. Large gym functions well.

#### Technology

Score is average.

Outlet placement throughout the school is average. There are movable digital displays in all studios along with whiteboards and some projectors. CTE space includes IT computer labs.

#### Satisfactory Categories (66-80%):

#### **Outdoor Learning and Activity**

Score is satisfactory.

There is limited outdoor learning spaces. No cistern was observed, and the garden space is underutilized.

#### **CTE and Career Connected Learning**

Score is satisfactory.

Travis offers a variety of CTE spaces including culinary courses in a commercial kitchen space.

#### Visual and Performing Arts

Score is satisfactory.

There are programs not in suitable spaces. The theater is adequately sized, but a few support spaces are lacking. The dressing rooms are undersized for the size of productions. A block box practice room was created near the stage. The visual art rooms and dance studio are satisfactory.

#### **Food Services**

Score is satisfactory.

The cafeteria is slightly undersized for the student capacity at the campus. There are multiple types of seating available. The kitchen is adequately sized.

#### Very Satisfactory Categories (81-100%):

#### Media Resources

Score is very satisfactory.

The library is close to the main entry but does not have a secure after-hours entry. The library is one large open space, and depending on the noise level, may not be conducive to quiet study. The furniture is set up to accommodate different group sizes. There is a computer lab, and movable digital displays that support technology.

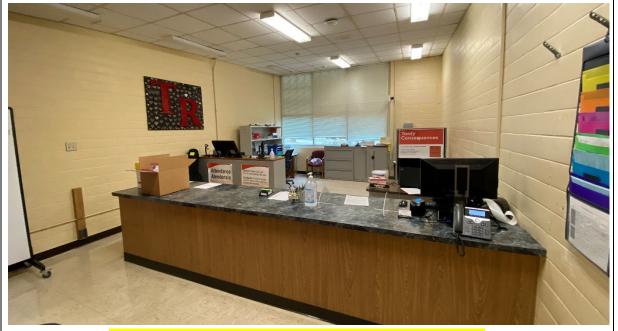

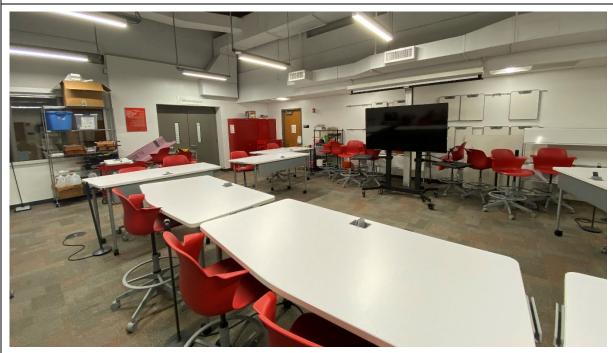
