<ul style="list-style-type: none">School Type ShiftProgramming Change	<p>Odom ES will no longer have a boundary and will merge with students from Sunset Valley ES as a school-wide Spanish dual-language program. While Odom ES neighborhood students will be reassigned to Pleasant Hill ES, they are encouraged to continue at Odom ES if enrolled in dual-language.</p> <p>Dual language students from Odom ES and Sunset Valley ES will be prioritized next year; other students can apply to participate in the program.</p> <p>See South Elementary School Updates for more information.</p>	<p>If you are enrolled in the dual-language program at Odom ES, we encourage you to stay and join the school-wide dual language program. You can also choose to attend Pleasant Hill ES.</p> <p>If you live in Odom ES's current boundary and are not in dual-language you can sign up for the program if you are in 1st grade or below, or go to Pleasant Hill ES. Additional case by case exceptions may also be made for dual-language enrollment.</p> <p>If you are a transfer student and are not enrolled in dual-language, you can return to your zoned school or apply to transfer to another campus.</p>	<p>See page for your new zoned school.</p> <p>We will prioritize the continuation of dual language programming for students participating in school-wide dual language at a nearby middle school and high school.</p>	N/A
