<ul> <li>Boundary Change,</li> <li>Receiving Students from Closure or Program Shift</li> <li>School Type Shift</li> </ul>	Reilly ES will no longer offer a school-wide dual language program and will instead operate as a traditional elementary school and welcome neighborhood students from Ridgetop ES, which will close. The school-wide dual language program will move to, and merge with, Wooten ES. Reilly will also have a boundary change with Harris ES.  Students participating in the Mandarin duallanguage program can continue this program at Doss ES or at the non-zoned Joslin ES Mandarin & Spanish Language Immersion Program.  See North Central Elementary School Updates for more information.	If you live in Reilly ES's current boundary you can continue to attend Reilly ES or apply for a priority seat at the school-wide dual language program at Wooten ES.  If you are a transfer student you can return to your zoned school or apply for a priority seat at the school-wide dual language program at Wooten ES.  There is room at Wooten ES to support all incoming Reilly ES students who wish to participate. You can also choose to attend one of the other locations providing school-wide dual language (Odom ES, Pickle ES, Sánchez ES) or in Joslin ES's Spanish and Mandarin immersion program.  We will monitor the number of emergent bilingual students enrolled at Reilly ES to see if a strand of dual language programming would be sustainable.	Reilly ES feeds 100% into Webb MS.  Due to Webb MS's TAP implementation, you may have the option to continue to Lamar MS, based on your address.	N/A
