<ul style="list-style-type: none">ClosureRelocating Program	<p>Winn Montessori building will be closed and its neighborhood students will be reassigned to Andrews ES, Hart ES, or Pecan Springs ES based on their address.</p> <p>The Montessori program will move to, and merge with, Govalle ES.</p> <p>See Northeast Elementary School Updates for more information.</p>	<p>If you live in Winn's current boundary you can attend your new zoned school or apply for a priority seat in the Montessori program at Govalle ES.</p> <p>If you are a transfer student you can apply for a priority seat in the Montessori program at Govalle ES, return to your zoned school, or apply to transfer to another campus.</p> <p>There is room at Govalle ES to support all incoming Winn Montessori students who wish to continue with the program.</p> <p>We plan to continue offering a dual language strand at Montessori in 2026–2027, with students merging from both campuses. As the program transitions to Govalle ES, we will carefully monitor enrollment and family interest.
