AISD educates approximately 85,000 students and embraces 129 diverse school communities in one of the fastest-growing, ever-changing metroplexes in the country. We partner with world-class universities, innovative businesses and nonprofit organizations and engaged community leaders to prepare our students for college, career and life.

AISD students have achieved their best performance under the highest, toughest accountability standards in the state’s history. Graduation rates have reached an all-time high of 84.1 percent and the district has embarked on graduation plans designed to meet the dynamic needs of the 21st century. the nation. And, our district has 261 National Board Certified Teachers—more than any school district in Texas.

Despite dwindling state resources, AISD has earned the highest ratings for its management of a \$1 billion budget from Moody’s Investors Service, Standard & Poor’s, and Fitch Ratings.

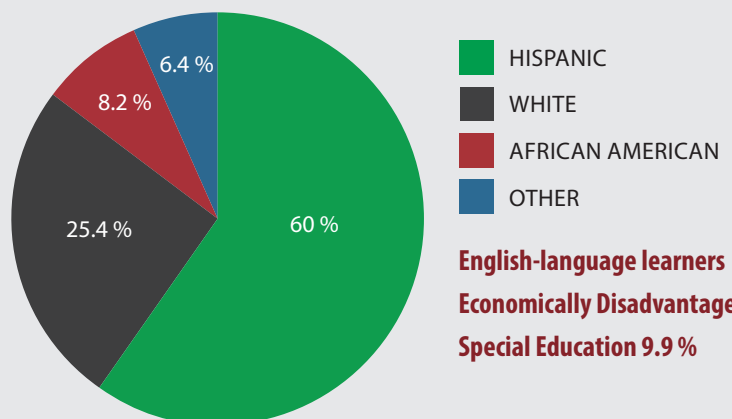

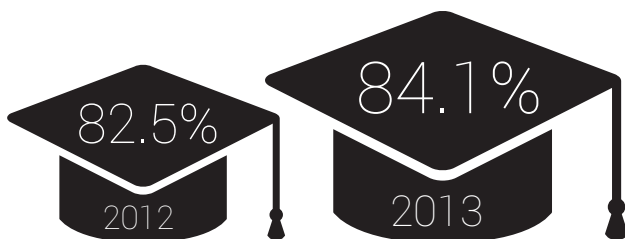
FY2014 BUDGET
