The Department of Special Education developed an Accommodations Toolkit with some general recommendations for accommodations to use while implementing the AISD Human Sexuality & Responsibility (HSR) curriculum. This is not an exhaustive list and teachers are reminded to always refer to a student's IEP first when considering what accommodations to utilize.

Below are specific examples of accommodations that teachers might implement when teaching the 7th grade HSR curriculum.

<ul> <li>For the anonymous question box provided during each lesson, consider the following:</li> <li>Provide a word/idea bank</li> <li>Provide written sentence stems</li> <li>Keep images available to generate ideas</li> <li>Allow student to dictate to teacher/aide or work with a responsible peer</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>To support comprehension of new</li> <li>vocabulary, consider the following: <ul> <li>Preview vocabulary</li> <li>Preview vocabulary or provide images for important vocabulary</li> <li>Provide vocabulary lists with user-friendly definitions and visuals</li> <li>Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Allow verbal responses	<ul> <li>Point out word parts and cognates</li> </ul>

## Lesson 1 - Introduction and Healthy Relationships

- Types of Relationships Partner Activity
  - Provide sentence stems to answer questions
  - Provide a word bank so the student can make choices
- Compare and Contrast Activity
  - Provide reading support, if needed
  - Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner
  - Add pictures to the cards or simplify vocabulary on cards
  - Allow the student to dictate to teacher/aide or work with a responsible peer

## Lesson 2 - Unhealthy Relationships and Abuse

- Provide a word bank or examples for the unhealthy characteristics activity
- Match Game: Unhealthy Characteristics Cards
  - Provide reading support, if needed
  - Allow the student to <u>dictate</u> to teacher/aide or work with a responsible peer
- Scenarios
  - Allow students to work with a partner

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- Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner
- Provide sentence stems or starters

#### Lesson 3 - Trafficking and Exploitation

- Red Flag Phrases
  - Allow students to work with a partner
  - Provide reading support, if needed
  - Provide sentence stems
- Jamboard or Padlet Activity
  - Provide gifs or memes to choose from
  - Allow the student to dictate to teacher/aide or work with a responsible peer

#### Lesson 4 - Communication and Boundaries

- Communication Scenarios
  - Allow students to work with a partner
  - Have visuals available to generate ideas
  - Give student sentence stems
  - Provide reading support, if needed
  - Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner

#### Lesson 5 - Reproductive Anatomy and Adolescent Development

- Review lesson ground rules
- Reproductive System Diagrams
  - Allow students to work with a partner
  - Have the first two letters of the words prefilled
  - Have all the words prefilled
  - Provide reading support, if needed
- The Physical and Emotional Changes of Puberty
  - Allow students to work with a partner
  - Provide reading support, if needed

#### Lesson 6 - Pregnancy and Abstinence

- Review lesson ground rules
- Consider having a class discussion on abstinence/sexual contact/sexual intercourse first to review the term and increase background knowledge

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- Decision Making Activity
  - Allow students to work with a partner
  - Provide reading support, if needed
  - Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner
  - Model and practice types of refusal (verbal and non-verbal)

#### Lesson 7 - Consequences of Sexual Activity

- Review lesson ground rules
- Methods of Birth Control Card Sort
  - Some student may need visual prompts for this activity
  - Allow students to work with a partner
- STI Facts
  - Allow students to work with a partner
  - Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner

## Lesson 8 - Digital Communication

- Imagine the Scene
  - For the writing activities, consider allowing students to draw, find a picture
  - Give students words or visuals to choose from
- Reaction Scenario Card Sort
  - Some student may need visual prompts for this activity
  - Allow students to work with a partner
  - Provide sentence starters or stems

#### Lesson 9 - Putting It All Together

- Let's Review Stations
  - Some student may need visual prompts for this activity
  - For students with mobility difficulties, assign a <u>student partner</u> to help guide around the room
  - Provide sentence starters or stems
- Putting It All Together Worksheet
  - Provide a note-taking format to support comprehension & recall (i.e., <u>graphic</u> <u>organizer</u>)
  - For the writing activities, consider allowing students to draw, find a picture
  - Allow students to work with a partner
