The Department of Special Education developed an Accommodations Toolkit with some general recommendations for accommodations to use while implementing the AISD Human Sexuality & Responsibility (HSR) curriculum. This is not an exhaustive list and teachers are reminded to always refer to a student's IEP first when considering what accommodations to utilize.

Below are specific examples of accommodations that teachers might implement when teaching the 8th grade HSR curriculum.

# For the **anonymous question box** provided during each lesson, consider the following:

- Provide a word/idea bank
- Provide written sentence stems
- Keep images available to generate ideas
- Allow student to dictate to teacher/aide or work with a responsible peer
- Allow verbal responses

# To support **comprehension of new vocabulary**, consider the following:

- <u>Preview vocabulary</u> or provide images for important vocabulary
- Provide vocabulary lists with user-friendly definitions and visuals
- Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner
- o Point out word parts and cognates

#### **Lesson 1 - Introduction and Healthy Relationships**

- Definition of a Relationship
  - Allow the student to dictate to teacher/aide or work with a responsible peer
  - Consider providing sentence stems to support student responses
- Types of Relationships Partner Activity
  - Provide sentence stems to answer questions
  - o Provide a word bank so the student can make choices
- Compare and Contrast Activity
  - o Provide reading support, if needed
  - Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner
  - Add pictures to the cards or simplify vocabulary on cards
  - Allow the student to dictate to teacher/aide or work with a responsible peer

## Lesson 2 - Unhealthy Relationships and Abuse

- The Respect Hotline Activity
  - Allow students with reading difficulties to work with a responsible peer
  - o Read the scenario aloud



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- o Provide sentence stems
- Quick Activity
  - For students with mobility difficulties, assign a <u>student partner</u> to help guide around the room

#### **Lesson 3 - Trafficking and Exploitation**

- Stages of Grooming Activity
  - Allow students to work with a partner
  - o Provide reading support, if needed
  - o Allow student to dictate to a teacher/aide or a responsible peer
  - Provide sentence starters and allow multimodal responses (auditory, AAC, gestural) for discussion activities
  - For students with mobility difficulties, assign a <u>student partner</u> to help guide around the room

#### **Lesson 4 - Communication and Boundaries**

- Communication Scenarios
  - o Allow students to work with a partner
  - Have visuals available to generate ideas
  - o Provide fill-in-the-blanks notes and/or sentences starters
  - o Provide reading support, if needed
  - o Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner
- Consent, Communication, and Boundaries Scenarios
  - Allow student to dictate to a teacher/aide
  - Allow student to use speech to text
  - Allow student to work with a responsible peer

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### **Lesson 5 - Reproductive Anatomy and Adolescent Development**

- Review lesson ground rules
- Reproductive System Diagrams
  - o Allow students to work with a partner
  - o Have the first two letters of the words prefilled
  - Have all the words prefilled
  - o Provide reading support, if needed
- The Physical and Emotional Changes of Puberty



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- Allow students to work with a partner
- o Provide reading support, if needed

#### **Lesson 6 - Pregnancy and Abstinence**

- Review lesson ground rules
- Allow for extra time, and individual discussions, as needed
- Fetal Development
  - Consider doing the activity in small groups or as a full class as recommended in the slide deck
- Decision Making Activity
  - o Allow students to work with a partner
  - o Provide reading support, if needed
  - Allow students with reading difficulties to read with a partner

#### **Lesson 7 - Consequences of Sexual Activity**

- Review lesson ground rules
- Methods of Birth Control Card Sort
  - Some student may need visual prompts for this activity
  - Allow students to work with a partner
- Condom Card Lineup
  - o Consider doing the activity as a full class as recommended in the slide deck

## **Lesson 8 - Digital Communication**

- Imagine the Scene
  - Allow students to draw responses
  - o Give students words or visuals to choose from

## Lesson 9 - Putting It All Together

- Let's Review Stations
  - Some student may need visual prompts for this activity
  - For students with mobility difficulties, assign a <u>student partner</u> to help guide around the room
  - Provide sentence starters or stems
- Putting It All Together Worksheet



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- Provide a note-taking format to support comprehension & recall (i.e., graphic organizer)
- For the fill-in-the-blank worksheet enlarge the font, chunk the activity into portions (paragraphs) with separate word banks
- o Allow students to work with a partner
- Allow the student to dictate to teacher/aide or work with a responsible peer
