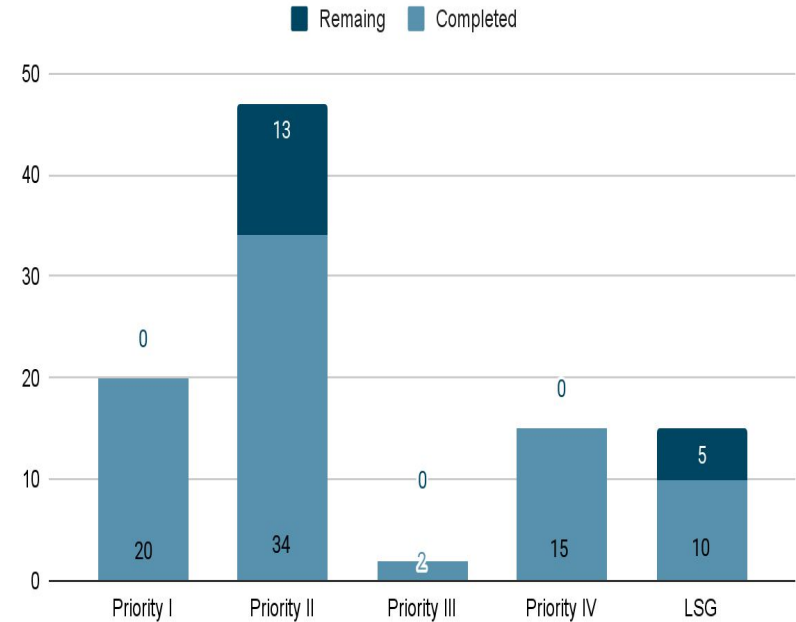

 - universal screening data for all campuses
 - student identification for Tier 2 and Tier 3
