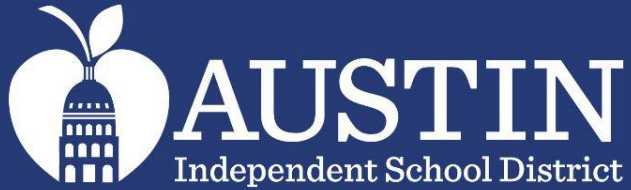

TEA Agreed Order

The TEA Order extension included transitioning from EdPlan to Special Programs Management (SPM). The intention is that this new system that supports best practices would ensure higher data quality and meet the reporting requirements of TEA Order P3.

This system must include specific data points for students served by special education, such as student ID, campus location, case manager, dates of consent, evaluation due dates, and eligibility determinations.

It must also track compensatory education considerations, Independent Educational Evaluation (IEE) requests, and triennial reevaluation data.

Priority III: Improve Data Management and Reporting Systems

Austin ISD will establish accurate systems to facilitate reporting on the district's progress in meeting federal and state special education requirements and its implementation of the terms of this Agreed Order to the board of trustees, families, community stakeholders, and TEA.

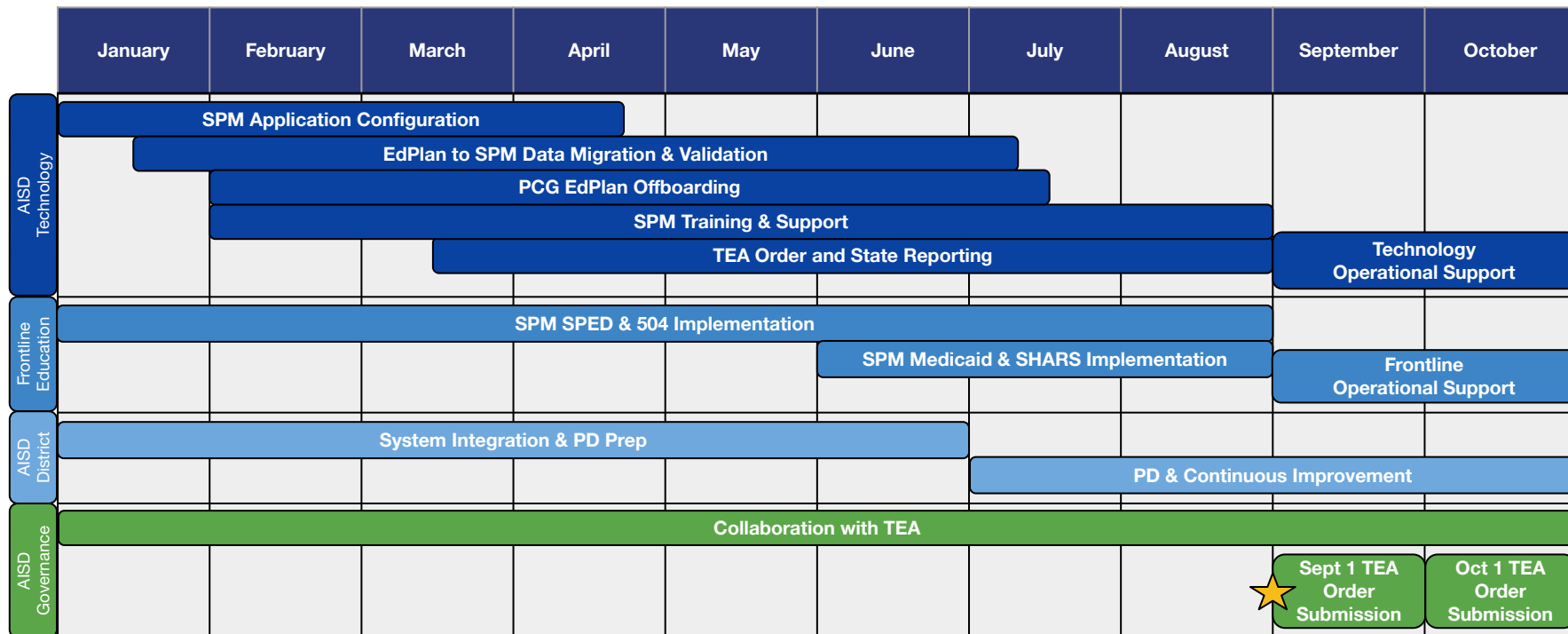

TEA has granted us an extension as we transition to a new SPED data management system, allowing us to:

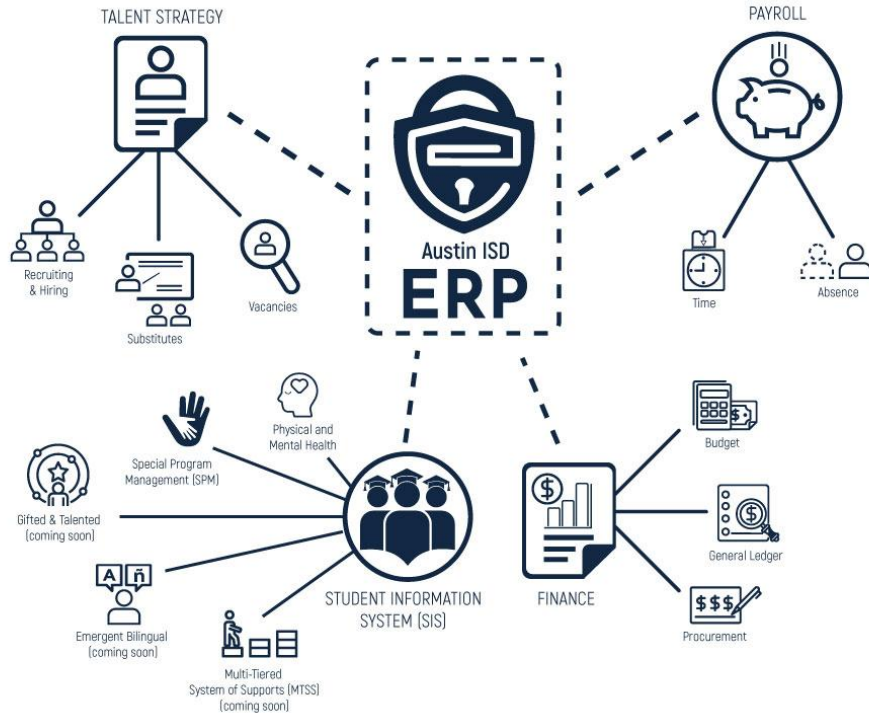
- Address TEA requirements cited in the Fall 2024

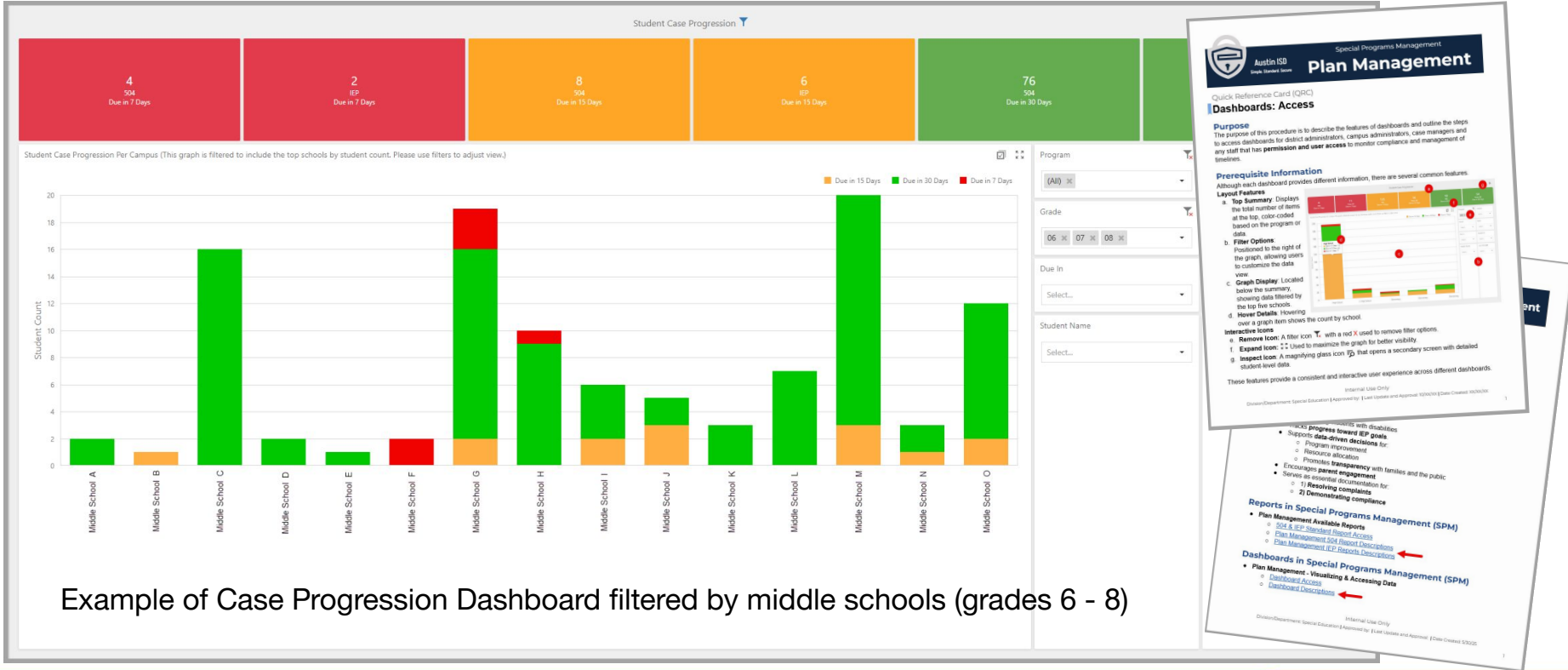

Special Programs Management (SPM) is a comprehensive platform that will assist to efficiently create, monitor, and review individual learning plans, while ensuring compliance. SPM is designed to streamline and automate the administration of individualized student support programs. These include:

- Special Education (IEPs)
- Section 504 Plans
- English Language Learner (ELL) Support
- Gifted and Talented Programs
