Austin ISD Special Education 18+ Transition Services are for students ages 18–21 who have met academic graduation requirements but need continued support to reach their employment, education, and independent living goals.



Flexible Schedules:

Options include part-day to allow for paid work, college classes, day programming, or other outside adult services.

All programs follow the standard Austin ISD school calendar.



Support:

Work with case managers to build adult schedules to fit student's interests and needs.



How to apply:

Interest forms are completed by the student's special education case manager their senior year.

Our 4 Unique 18+ Programs

Go Project

The Go Project is based at variety of community sites throughout Austin.

Student focus is on employment, education, independent living, and recreation skills.

Greenleaf NCS

A partnership program for students with autism and other neurodivergent conditions focusing on social skills and wellness.

Flexible schedules to allow students to participate in outside jobs or therapies to foster community belonging that can last beyond age 22.

Project SEARCH

Students work with the Texas Workforce Commission and Goodwill Industries to obtain competitive employment.

The one-year, unpaid internship at Baylor Scott & White (Oak Hill) is aimed at competitive employment.

Transition to Life in the Community (TLC)

Transition to Life in the Community (TLC) features smaller student-to-staff ratios with programming for students with higher medical or behavioral support needs.
