 - In collaboration with the traffic, safety, and education teams, a plan is in place to offer safety courses for student walkers, bikers, and drivers.
 - Students who park on campus will be required to attend a safety course to ensure they understand relevant laws and the risks of noncompliance.
 - Melvin Bedford asked whether principals require students to use AISD transportation when attending AISD sporting events.
 - AISD can provide transportation whenever requested, though availability depends on driver staffing.
