

## Mollie Barrington Early College Prep. Parent Involvement Policy 2025 – 2026

The main purpose of the *Barrington Early College Prep*'s Parent Involvement Policy is to develop a positive environment to increase parent and community involvement in the education of our students.

- I. The Parental Involvement Policy will be distributed during the first six weeks of the school year.
- II. The school staff will be responsible to establish a two-way communication process with parents and families regarding their children's academic progress. This should include, but not limited to: progress reports, report cards, telephone calls, emails, notes, newsletters, etc.
- III. The school will make every effort to communicate with parents in a language that is understandable. Communication with parents may include, but not limited to: homework, electronic mail, texts, newsletters, meetings, virtual learning, etc.
- IV. Barrington Elementary will hold an annual meeting to parents and community during the first six weeks to share and discuss the Title One Program.
- V. Meetings with the Principal will be held once a month.
- VI. Parents will be given the opportunity to provide input and make recommendations regarding the Campus Improvement Plan, the Title One program, Parent Compact and the Parent Involvement Policy through the Parent Advisory Council, the CAC and/or any other scheduled parent meetings.
- VII. During the first six weeks of school, parents will be provided information regarding the school's curriculum and types of academic assessments used to measure student progress/proficiency levels that the students are expected to meet.
- VIII. In order to meet the changing needs of our school, the Parent Involvement Policy will be reviewed/updated during the Spring session.
