Parent Engagement Policy



The faculty, family/parents, staff, and community members of Blazier Elementary shall develop and agree upon a written policy for parental and family engagement during the development and review of the campus improvement plan.

- I. The Parental Engagement Policy will be distributed during the first nine weeks of the school year.
- II. It will be the responsibility of school staff to establish a two way communication process with parents and families regarding their children's academic progress. This should include, but not be limited to: progress reports, report cards, telephone calls, notes, newsletters, etc.
- III. The school will make every effort to communicate with parents in a language that is understandable. Communication with parents may include, but not be limited to: email, newsletters, meetings, websites, social media, robocalls, etc.
- IV. Blazier Intermediate School will hold an annual September during the first 9 weeks to discuss the Title I school-wide program.
- V. A Principal/Admin & Parent Coffee will be held 5 times throughout the school year.
- VI. Parents will be given the opportunity to provide input and make recommendations regarding the Campus Improvement Plan, the Title I program, Family/Parent Compact and the Parent Engagement Policy through the CAC or parent meetings (PTA).
- VII. Blazier parents have access to information regarding the school's curriculum and types of academic assessments used to measure student progress/proficiency levels that students are expected to meet/
- VIII. In order to meet the changing needs of our school, the Parent Engagement Policy will be reviewed/updated during the annual Campus Improvement Plan revision process.
